

# Special Voters Meeting Summary June 29, 2025

Voters unanimously approved a net zero impact (income equaling expenses) at just over 3 million dollars for the fiscal year 2025-2026.

Voters also ratified Mark Beitz, filling Spiritual Life Chairman vacancy for the remainder of the term (1 year). New LES board members: Luke Abitz, Brad Beck and Tucker Paschen were also ratified by voters.

# Council Meeting Summary June 24, 2025

#### **Financial Status:**

Good News as we enter our last month of the fiscal year. We are currently at a large surplus that will be relied upon in June, as that is historically our worst month of the year. Our Treasurer is projecting ending the fiscal year with potentially a surplus in the area of \$100,000. This would be a wonderful blessing, as last fiscal year we finished the year with about a \$120,000 deficit. Pray these projections are realized.

### **Approved Motions:**

Council approved the following Motions:

- Council approved a request for a special fund to be created to fund a new electronic piano for school, as requested by LES board.
- Council officially appointed Mark Beitz to fill the Spiritual Life Chairman vacancy. This will need to be ratified by Voters.
- Council approved new LES board members, also to be ratified by Voters. New LES Board members are Luke Abitz, Brad Beck, and Tucker Paschen.
- Council unanimously approved the recommendations from the Wage Study group, with the first round of recommendations becoming part of the 2025-26 Ministry Funding Plan.
- Motion was approved to ask Mr. Jason Dutcher (new 4<sup>th</sup> grade teacher)
  if he would be willing to accept additional responsibilities of
  "Webmaster" and "Worship Service Technology Lead" as he has
  indicated interest and passion for these areas.
