School News and Student Info Updates: This newsletter, known as "School News" is the primary avenue through which school announcements will be made. Today, a hard copy will go home with each child at St. Paul, an electronic copy will go out via SwiftReach K12, and you can also find it online (www.stpaulappletonwi.com, 'School' tab, then 'Falcon Newsletter'). NEXT WEEK, you will ONLY receive the news notification by whichever means you've set up in SwiftReach K12. To adjust your Alert Preferences, please log in to PowerSchool on (https://wels.powerschool.com/public/). On the left side of your screen, click 'SwiftReach SwiftK12', then on 'Alert Preferences' on the right. Click the Alert Preferences button and make sure all options are checked for your mobile number and email to ensure you are receiving any and all communications from St. Paul. This is how we communicate with our families, including notifying you when school is closed, etc. Because this is being sent through an automated system, it is imperative that you update your contact information via the InfoSnap link that was emailed to you over the summer. Mr. Hoffman is re-sending links to anyone who has not completed their update. Please watch for an email today from 'noreply@infosnap.com. If you don't see it, check your 'spam' or 'promotions' folders. This is your opportunity to update your emergency contacts, phone numbers, allergies, etc. Even if your info is the same, please go through the link and check everything. If you need another link sent to you please email Mr. Hoffman (phoffman@stpaulappletonwi.com). The InfoSnap links will only be available until this Thursday, 9/3. Hard copies of the newsletter and lunch menu will always be available in the school office.

PowerSchool App: Don't forget to upload the PowerSchool App to your smart phone! From the App, you can view your child's grades, lunch balance, and attendance. Enter the WELS Schools code 'NGBR' for access.

New Health Screening Procedures: Starting on Tuesday, September 8, St. Paul will follow the updated CDC guidelines of not conducting health screenings at school. Please use the attachments to this newsletter to conduct daily home symptom screening of children by their parents, guardians, or caregivers to promptly identify illness. Please remember that students should not attend school when they are sick, and may return to school depending on the duration of the illness, type of symptoms, laboratory testing for COVID or other illnesses, and whether or not the student has been in close contact with an individual with COVID-19. Teachers and staff will continue to monitor students for overt symptoms of illness during the school day.

FVL Shared Info: As a member of the FVL Schools partnership, schools do share personal information with Fox Valley Lutheran High School as St. Paul Lutheran School offers programs and events through the high school.

Hot Lunch Policy: Hot lunch accounts, meals and payments, are monitored in Power School. You may check your child's account balance at any time on the app or your desktop. The price of a student meal for the 2020-2021 school year is \$2.90 per meal, \$0.40 per reduced meal, and \$0.00 per free meal. Free and reduced meal application forms are found in the school office or through Karen Briggs in the hot lunch kitchen. Adult meals are \$3.75 per meal.

All accounts should be maintained with a positive balance (payments to be made in the office via cash or check). If your account is low or has a negative balance, a reminder text and/or email will be sent automatically through PowerSchool (check your 'Alert Preferences'!). If a student has a negative balance less than \$25 at meal time, he or she will still be able to charge a meal. If the negative balance is more than \$25, meals can no longer be charged. If no lunch is brought from home, a light option would be provided. Reminders will continue to be sent until the negative balance is paid off. The school board will be notified of any unpaid balances.
