ONLINE SUNDAY SCHOOL: As we await the reopening of our "in-person Sunday School," we have a great online alternative. Our Wisconsin Synod is offering pre-recorded Sunday School lessons for children Pre-K to Grade 8. Videos are being produced for the first quarter of the Sunday School year, from September 13, through December 6, 2020. The lessons are taught by experienced WELS teachers.

When you go to https://online.nph.net/ss-at-home a screen will appear inviting you to choose the grade level(s) you prefer – either PreK-K; or Grades 1-2; or Grades 3-4; or Grades 5-8. Hard copies of the lesson are available by calling the church office, 733-9061.

The videos are posted on Fridays and can be accessed at any time after that. They run about 10 minutes, and are intended for children and their parents. Several members have already commented on the exceptional quality and content of the lessons.

Most of us know children who are not hearing God's word and who know little about Jesus and His love. Pass this information on to them and to their parents. There is no charge.

St. Paul Sunday School Plans for 2020: We are happy to announce that St. Paul will begin offering in-person Sunday School again, starting Sunday, October 4th. Based on feedback from several families, we have decided to move forward with two options for Sunday School this year. For those who would prefer in-person Sunday School, we have teachers who are happy to share the Word of God with your children every Sunday. For those who prefer online Sunday School, we will provide weekly lesson sheets and a link to an online lesson. We will follow this format for the next few months and then will revaluate based on interest and on the state of the pandemic. The online video links will be posted on our Facebook page and on our website www.stpaulappletonwi.com starting October 4th. Student Lesson Guides and Worksheets will be mailed to you.

In-person Sunday School will follow the same regulations as our elementary school, which means masks (except for those 5 and under) and distancing. which option you plan to take advantage of. Also provide the number of children who will attend. Please reply by Friday, September 25th.
