Our school has been approved through the USDA to offer free lunches for all of our students at St. Paul Lutheran School regardless if you qualify for free and reduced lunches. This free hot lunch program will begin on Monday, September 21 and will continue through December 31 or until the funding for this program is extended or depleted. We are also working on an application to cover any hot lunches that were purchased since the beginning of the school year. We will let you know when this application is processed and when/if we will be able to credit accounts for those who have eaten hot lunch since the beginning of the school year.
