iReady Assessments: The students in grades K-8 are completing the formative assessments through iReady for Math and Reading. These assessments are one of many tools that our teachers use at St. Paul to help guide students in their learning path throughout the school year. The iReady assessments will be administered three times over the course of a school year- fall, winter, and spring. The first assessments in the fall will provide a baseline for our students as the teachers monitor progress for each individual student and their classroom. The baseline assessment will also help determine the students' level for their online personalized instruction for math and reading.
