



School Mission Statement:

Using God's Word as our guide, St. Paul Lutheran School will raise up future generations of Christians in our community by assisting parents in the Christian teaching of their children and by striving for excellence in all areas of instruction.

Worship Services at St. Paul Lutheran Church: Beginning this Sunday, 9/13, St. Paul is adding a 3rd service to the schedule. We anticipate an increase in attendance after the Labor Day holiday, and this will give worshipers the opportunity to social distance appropriately. All are invited to attend! Services will be Sunday mornings at 8:00, 9:15, and 10:30. Monday evenings remain at 6:00pm. Due to the governor's mask mandate, face coverings are required at all services, with the exception of those with medical reasons preventing them from wearing one. *"I rejoiced with those who said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the LORD.'"* (Psalm 122:1)

Chapel Service Tomorrow: Our school will come together for a socially distanced chapel service tomorrow morning at 8:10. The theme for the week is 'Run to Christ...and Learn from Him'. These services are held on the second and fourth Wednesdays of the month throughout the school year. Offerings may be brought in on these days by our students to benefit a mission project which changes each semester. First semester mission money will go toward Costa Maya Ministries in Mexico (learn more about this mission below!). Offerings may be given directly to your child's teacher.

First Semester Mission Project: Costa Maya Ministries, Mexico: People have referred to Costa Maya Ministries (CMM) as taking the gospel to the end of the earth. The mission is as far south on the Yucatan Peninsula as most people go. The Yucatan Peninsula has 5 million people, and no Lutheran churches. New Health Screening Procedures: Starting **TODAY**, St. Paul will follow the updated [CDC guidelines](#) of not conducting health screenings at school. Please still do a temp check each morning, and reference CDC guidelines to **conduct daily home symptom screening** of children by their parents, guardians, or caregivers to promptly identify illness. Please remember that students should not attend school when they are sick, and may return to school depending on the duration of the illness, type of symptoms, laboratory testing for COVID or other illnesses, and whether or not the student has been in close contact with an individual with COVID-19. Teachers and staff will continue to monitor students for overt symptoms of illness during the school day.

St. Paul Facemasks: We currently have Falcon masks on order in three different styles. These masks are only available in one size, however, they have adjustable ear straps to hopefully accommodate our 'little' Falcons. We anticipate that they will be delivered in the next week or two and will be sold on a first come, first served basis in the office for \$8 each. We will have 50 of each style available and \$1.15 from each mask will go toward the purchase of the new ionizer machine that will be used to clean/sanitize surfaces within the school. Your child may have come home with St. Paul facemasks last week. These were our first order of masks through a different company that were NOT what we ordered. Feel free to keep these masks at no charge if you are able to utilize them. We do have some youth sizes left in the office if you'd like a pack, but bear in mind they are not adjustable and run very small. They will also be given out on a first come, first served basis.
