#### **PowerSchool**

PowerSchool is our online Student Information System. It provides you the opportunity to view assignments, grades, lunch balance, and attendance. Most of all, it allows us to **communicate with you through text, email, and phone**. If your information has changed or you would like to update contacts to receive alerts via text, email, and phone, login to your account, on a laptop, to make these changes or contact the office for assistance. The web address for PowerSchool is **wels.powerschool.com**.

In order to receive texts through our PowerSchool system, you need to sign up by texting "Yes" to 67587.

There is a **PowerSchool APP** available for your mobile device. Once you have an active PowerSchool account, you can download and register the APP. You will need to enter your log in credentials and our school code **NGBR** so that it links you with St. Paul Lutheran School.

## **T-Shirt Orders**

Please preorder your child's school t-shirt by August 1 by filling in the information on this FORM. The cost of each student's (K-8) t-shirt is included in your registration fees. If you would like additional t-shirts for your family, the cost is \$15 each, payable at the office. The shirts are used during Falcon wear days, field trips, school-sponsored events, and to share your school with your neighbor.

## **Home Visits with your Teacher**

Your child's homeroom teacher has already been in contact with you and provided an introductory email message to you. If you have not received this email, check your spam and junk folders as it may have ended up there, otherwise contact (contacts included in this newsletter) your child's teacher and notify them you have not received this message. They will also be contacting you to schedule a home visit. These visits are very important for several reasons.

The visit help sets the stage for good teacher/home communication throughout the year and set the stage for a partnership in Christian education between teacher and parents. It also gives the teacher time to get to know the family of the student, which will allow them to serve your child in the classroom.

In addition to these benefits, there is important information that you will be receiving that you will absolutely need. You will be receiving information regarding back-to-school procedures, registration materials, and your teacher's expectations for the school year.

Please do all you can to make sure that you and your child will be available for a visit with your teacher(s). These visits are such a valuable tool for the start of the school year.

St. Paul Lutheran School (K-8) doors open at 7:30 AM for student drop off. You may drive up and drop off children at the Harris Street entrance; otherwise, park in the parking lot and escort children to their classrooms. Please do not drop children off in the parking lot unless you are escorting children into the building. Also, please do not park near the Harris Street entrance to drop children off, rather use the parking lot. All students should proceed to their classrooms upon drop off. Kindergarten children need to be signed in and out by an authorized adult each day. Students need to be picked up from their classroom by 3:30 PM. Any remaining students not registered for sports' practices will be required to sign up and utilize the after school care program.

## **Lunch Program**

St. Paul is part of the Federal National School Lunch Program. The price of a student meal for the 2025-2026 school year is \$3.50 per meal, \$0.40 per reduced meal, and \$0.00 per free meal. A milk only option is available for \$0.45. Adult meals are \$4.50 per meal. It is strongly encouraged that you review the Federal Free & Reduced information/forms that will be provided at your family home visit. If you may qualify for this program, please fill out the free/reduced application and return in to the office. Since this application is also utilized for this program and other Federal Title services that we are currently participating in at St. Paul, we are requesting that families who may qualify for Free and Reduced Meals complete this application.
