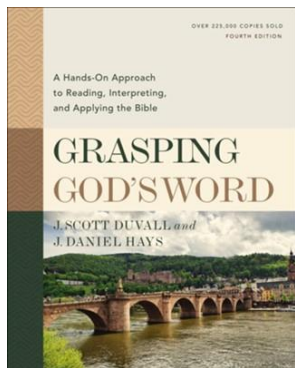

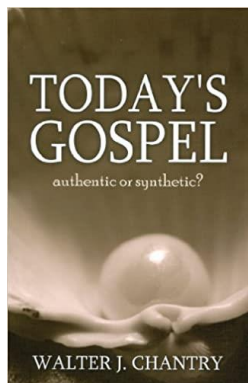

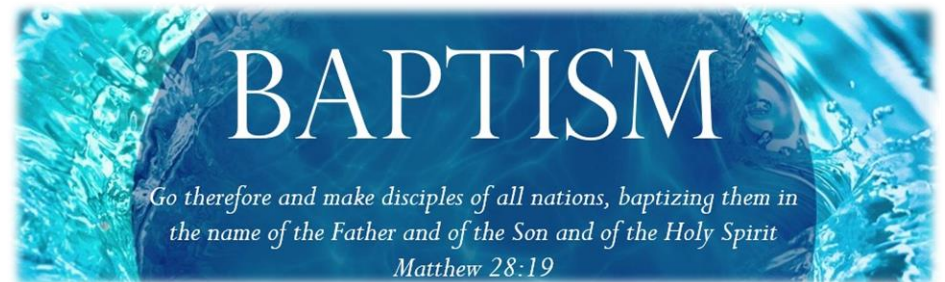

HYGIENE

- Combs
- Hairbrushes

- Non-liquid lip balm (unmedicated)
