Hymn Series Featured Song: "Have Thine Own Way, Lord" This morning's featured 'song from the storm' was written by Adelaide A. Pollard in 1902. Pollard lived in Iowa, but after finishing her schooling in elocution and physical culture, she moved to Chicago where she became a teacher in several girls' schools. Though she loved teaching, Pollard had a strong desire to be a missionary in Africa. She was able to make that dream happen for a brief period of time in her younger years, but returned home shortly thereafter. Later in life, desperate to return to the missionary life she felt God wanted her to lead, she tried to raise funds so that she might make her way back to Africa. Incapable of raising the needed money to fund the journey, she found herself experiencing a "distress of soul." In this state of discouragement, she attended a prayer meeting and was greatly moved by the prayer of an elderly woman who, omitting the usual requests for blessings, simply humbled herself before God by saying, "It really doesn't matter what you do with us, Lord - just have your way with our lives." Upon returning home that evening, Miss Pollard was inspired to write the words of the hymn we know today as "Have Thine Own Way, Lord." Though she wrote the words as a reminder to herself to trust in God's plan for her life in the midst of disappointment, the words speak to us, still today.
