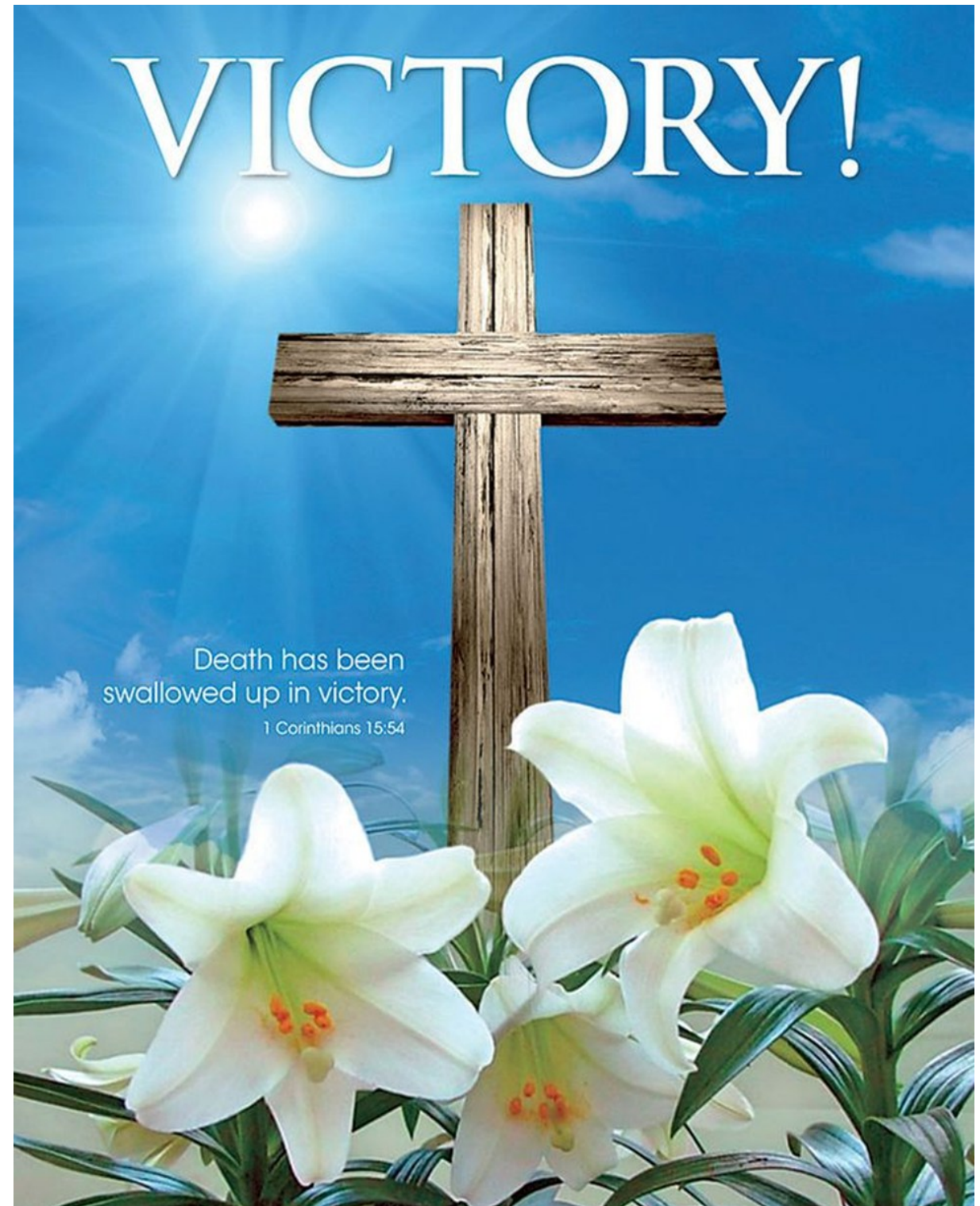


## Matthew 28:1-10 NRSVUE

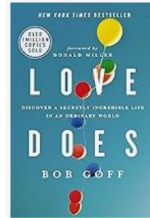

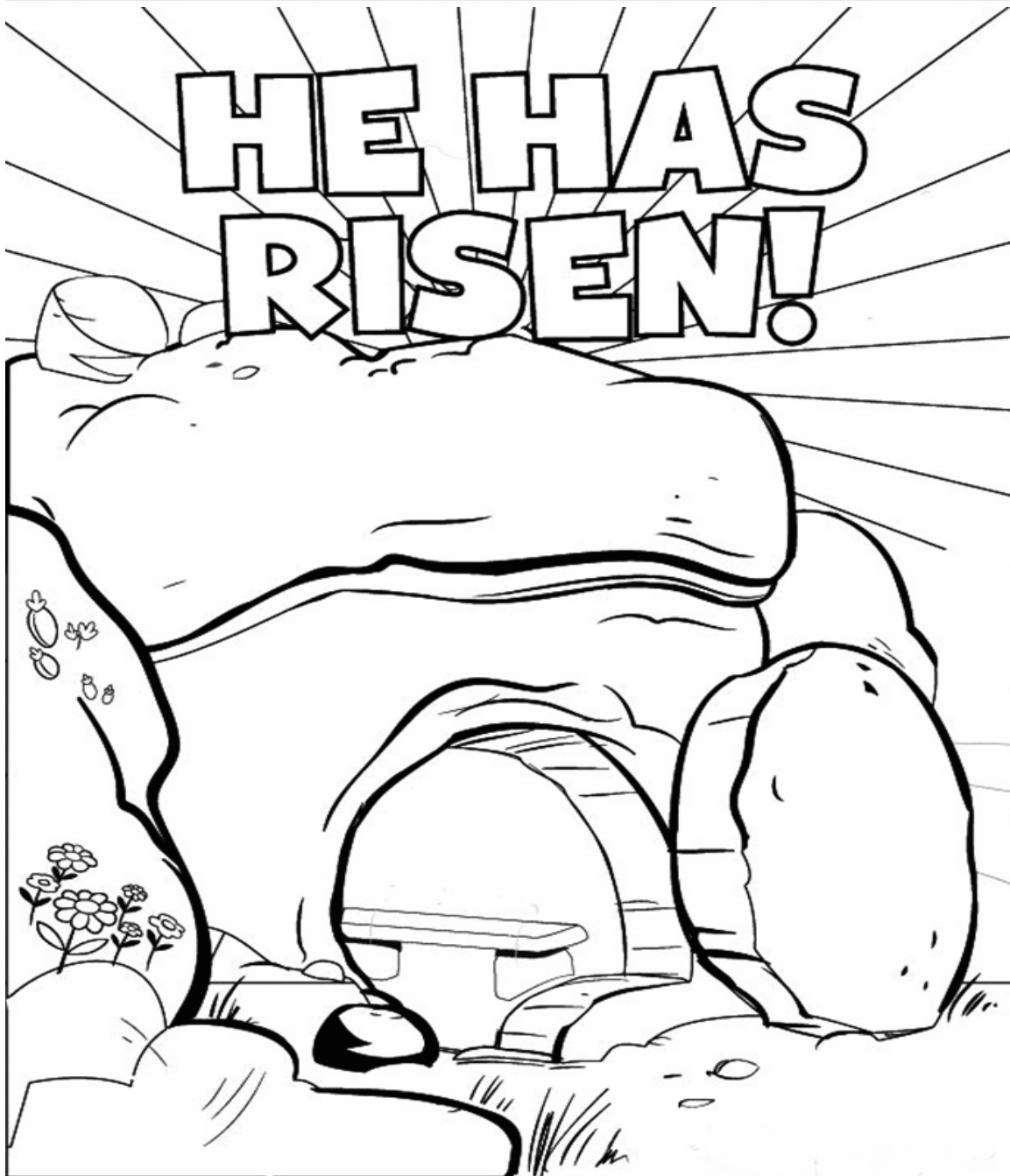
