7th-12th grade class: 1-2 times per month

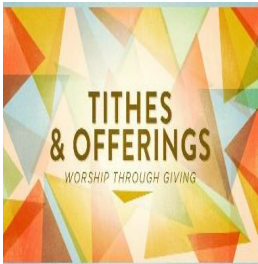

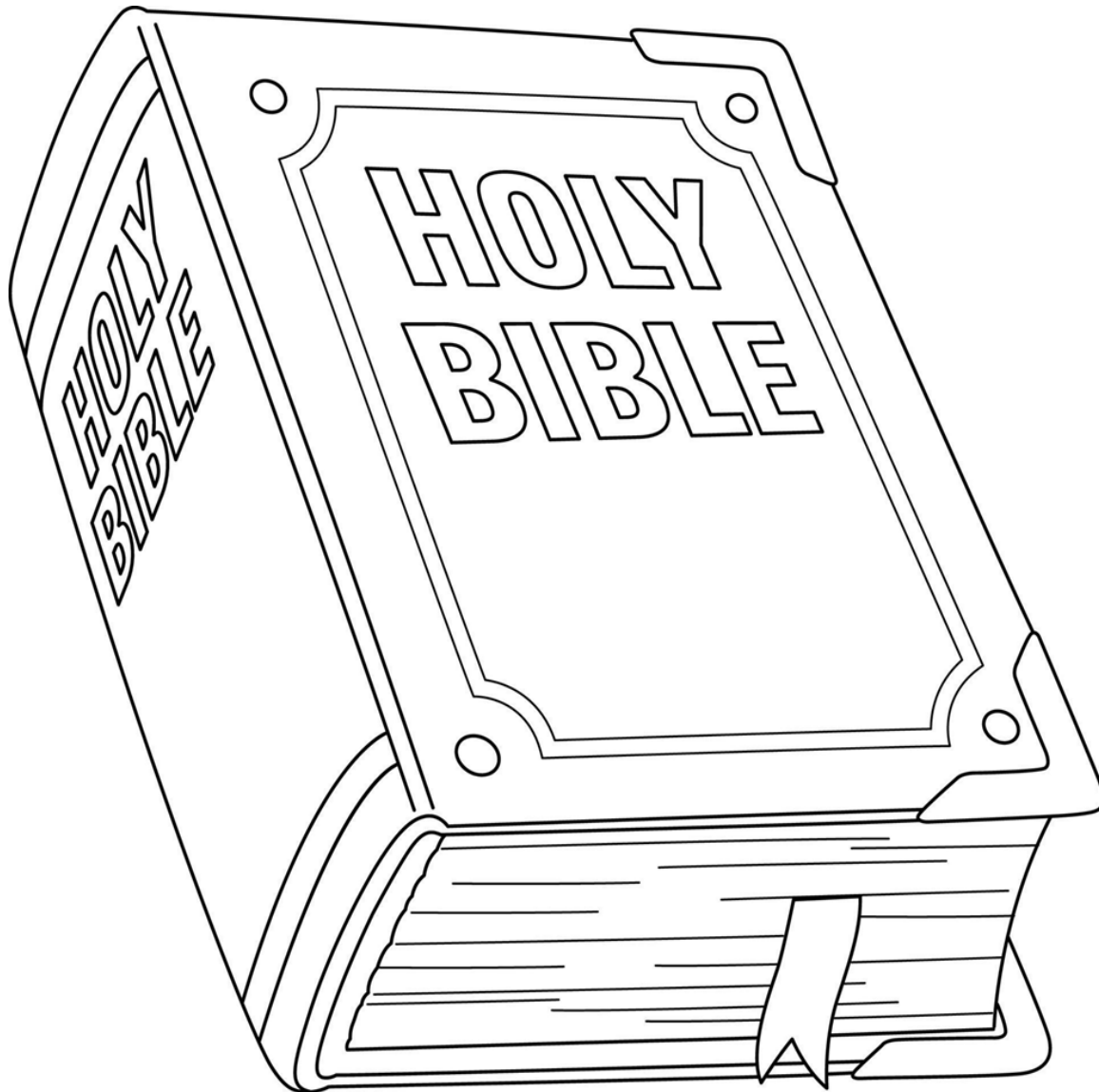
Bethel Website Resource Spotlight

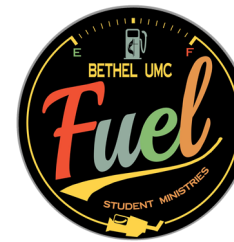

New Sermon Series: Beginning September 21st, Pastor Jim will be starting a new sermon series entitled, "Praise Him In This Storm?: Seeking God's presence in the midst of hardship and lament." The lectionary offers the prophet Jeremiah and we will study Jeremiah/Lamentations as they are believed to be linked and authored together. Jeremiah was a failed prophet. The Israelites did not repent and everything happened to bring the Israelites out of their homeland and into exile. How is God present with us in the midst of our storms? How is God with us even when we are disobedient? How is God at work in our darkest hours? We will think about these questions and more in our next series.

In concurrence with Pastor Jim's sermon series, the 8:00 & 11:00 services will experience a "Hymn Series" as well, entitled "Songs From the Storm." Some of the most powerful hymns in the Christian tradition were not penned in moments of peace, but in the crucible of suffering. They arose not from ease, but from aching loss, deep trial, and desperate hope.
