What is King's Kids?

King's Kids is a group for K-2nd grade students. Our goal is to provide an opportunity for older children to experience God through His gift of music.

When do they meet?

They meet each Wednesday night from 6:00-6:45 in the Bethel UMC Music Room.

What do they do there?

During rehearsals, the children sing fun and exciting songs that support specific religious concepts, listen to and act out Bible stories, play music theory games, make simple crafts, play instruments and even learn to read and write their own music!

When do they perform?

The children present musical offerings during various 9:15 and 11:00 worship services periodically throughout the year. They also take part in a musical/special program each Winter and Spring.

Is there any cost?
