WHY READ THE BIBLE?

In 2017, Lifeway Research conducted a study to identify what factor most contributes to the spiritual health of professing Christians. One practice had the biggest impact: Regular Bible Reading. As Trevin Wax concluded, "Routine Bible reading can change your life."

Most people want to read the Bible because they know it nourishes the soul, but they have no plan to read it. Consider using this two-year Bible reading plan to discipline yourself for the purpose of Godliness. God's Spirit uses God's Word to transform lives, but we have to fill our minds and hearts with the truth of God's Word. For God's glory and your joy, will you join us?

SEVEN TIPS FOR READING YOUR BIBLE By Stephen Witmer

First, if at all possible, use the Bible reading plan together with other people. This will provide accountability and shared fruit-bearing.

Second, you may find some passages boring and difficult but remember all scripture is "breathed out by God and profitable..." (2 Tim. 3:16-17).

Third, do the whole reading for each day, but look for a "best thought" for each day. Latch on to a truth you can meditate on and preach to yourself for the rest of the day.

Fourth, as you come to the word each day, ask God to open the eyes of your heart and mind to see splendor and majesty (Psalm 119:18; 119:36; Psalm 90:14).

Fifth, let your prayers for others emerge out of what you read. Read the Scripture and then pray through the passage for yourself and others.

Sixth, because some readings will be shorter than others, read the shorter readings more carefully and more meditatively. Chew on God's word and savor it.

Seventh, look for ways to practically live out the reading (James 1:22).
Ask, how will I trust and obey Jesus in light of this text?
