- 3) You need to know what God's word means. Study God's word, don't just devotional-ize it. Use a good study Bible to check your conclusions.
- 4) You need to meditate on God's word. This means that you slow down and ask questions, dwell on it, think over it so as to apply it. Slow down and ponder God's word. It's better to read a little slowly, than to read a lot in a hurry.
- 5) You need to respond in prayer. Take the most penetrating truth and PRAY it. P – Praise God. R – Repent. A – Ask God. Y – Yield to God.
- 6) You need to obey God's word. Do not merely be a reader and a hearer, but be a doer (James 1:22). Learn to experience the blessing of trusting God's word enough to obey God's word.
