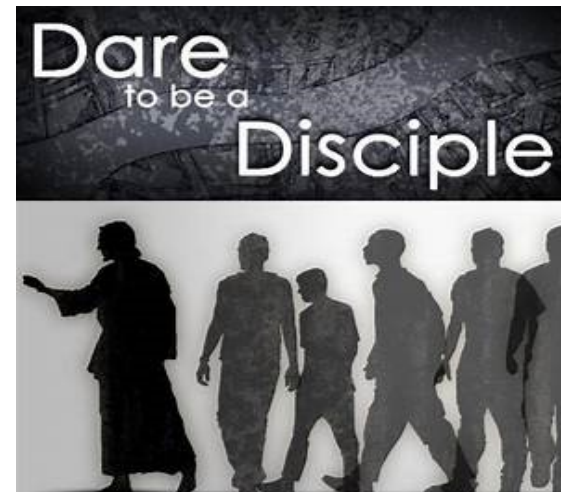


The Making of a Fisher of Men
Mark 1: 16-18
Luke 5: 1-11

Jesus is in the process of building a core group of world changing disciples who would eventually preach and bear much fruit. They would take the Gospel and begin the world wide expansion of God's Kingdom. "If the Son of God thought it necessary to focus his life on a small group of men, we are fooling ourselves to think we can mass-produce disciples today. God's design for taking the gospel to the world is a slow, intentional, simple process that involves every one of His people sacrificing every facet of their lives to multiply the life of Christ in others." -David Platt.

1. Jesus desires to interrupt your fishing trip. V. 1-3.
 - A. When was the last time that Jesus stepped into your boat, interrupted your life for the sake of Kingdom work?
 - B. "He has the right to interrupt your life. He is Lord. When you accepted Him as Lord, you gave him the right to help himself to your life anytime he wants." -Henry Blackaby
2. Jesus will call you to deeper waters. V. 4-5.
 - A. "Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing, but at your word I will let down the nets." He acknowledged his relationship with Jesus, MASTER. He acknowledged trust in Jesus, AT YOUR WORD. These were two important factors to the large catch he was about to enjoy.
 - B. When we acknowledge him as our Master and trust his word, we will be used in mighty ways for His glory.
 - C. When ordinary common place people make the magnanimous decision to allow Jesus Christ to mold and shape their life, God will accomplish the superabundant through them.
3. Jesus wants to show you the potential impact of your life. V. 5-11.
 - A. Many people will not go into the deep water to follow Christ because of the fear that accompanies it. Notice that Jesus speaks into the fear of the disciples, "Do not be afraid, from now on you will catch men."
 - B. "No one can sum up all God is able to accomplish through one solitary life, wholly yielded, adjusted, and obedient to him." DL Moody.
 - C. God has an extraordinary purpose for your life. Oswald Chambers says, "All of God's people are ordinary people who have been made extraordinary by the purpose he has given them."
