

1st-6th Art Supply Lists

Priority List - These items are the basic supplies needed for students to fully participate in art class. Auburn Hills Christian is providing pencils, erasers, glue sticks, glue, sharpies and masking tape.

If a brand is specified, it is based on my experience with the quality and how long these products will last. They are generally only a little more expensive, but will last the whole year. I do not advise purchasing art supplies at the dollar store. Often you can find items on sale at Target, Walmart, Office Depot, etc., cheaper than the dollar store. Items that are okay to purchase at the dollar store will have a DS next to them.

- **Box, labeled with name, to hold ALL art supplies - DS** (tool aisle has a larger box suitable for housing all supplies or a shoe sized box)
- **Canister pencil sharpener to catch shavings - DS**
- **24 count minimum CRAYOLA crayons**
- **Crayola or Mr. Sketch markers**
- **Crayola or Prang watercolor paint set**
- **Scissors**
- **Ruler - DS**
- **Art smock or large shirt to protect clothes** (Your student must be able to tie and untie or put their smock on without help. Please consider this when selecting an art smock style for them. Have the practice at home to make sure they are able to manage this please.)

The following supplies are encouraged for your students art supplies, but each lesson will be able to be completed with the above supplies. This supply list will provide your student with broader exposure to a variety of mediums.

Colored chalk pastels

Variety of paint brush size
