- 5. If selected, complete a follow-up report at the end of the grant period and submit it to FBC-Brewster by the designated deadline.

- 4. No applicant is guaranteed a grant.
- 5. Grant awardees may re-apply in the future.
- 6. The decision of the selection committee is final.
- 7. Grant recipients agree to attend the FBC Morning Worship service on Sunday, June 8, 2025, at 10:30 am to receive their award and speak about their project.
- 8. Grant recipients agree to submit a final report documenting the use of the grant 1 year from the award date.
