1. Applicants should be based in Putnam County, NY, and be a 501(c)3 charity.
2. FBC-Brewster reserves the right to refuse any application not in alignment with our mission, goals, and philosophy.
3. No applicant is guaranteed a grant.
4. Grant awardees may re-apply in the future.
5. The decision of the selection committee is final.
6. Grant recipients agree to attend the FBC Sunday Morning Worship service on Sunday, June 8, 2025, at 10:30 am to receive their award and speak about their organization.
7. Grant recipients agree to submit a final report documenting the use of the grant 1 year from the award date.
