# Mark's Musings



Holes of the second sec

To all God's holy people in Christ Jesus at Philippi, together with the overseers and deacons. Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. I thank my God every time I remember you. In my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this, that he who began a good work in your will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

In July and continuing through August (finishing up in the first couple weeks of September), we've been taking a closer look at Paul's letter to the Philippians, with the idea of "re-framing" the way we approach our lives as we strive to follow our Lord Jesus Christ. Likewise, collectively we can look to re-frame the way we live as a church – a koinonia (Greek for fellowship) of people striving to be God's people for our community.

Consider this following quote:

Framing is a mental structure that is built upon the beliefs you have about yourself, your roles, your circumstances, and about other people. It is a structure you use to ascribe meaning to given circumstances. In other words, the meaning you ascribe to any event is dependent upon how you frame it in your mind. As such, your frames shape how you see the world, how you see yourself, how you view others, and how you interpret your life.

Look at it in terms of Paul's word to the church at Philippi, as he wrote to them:

I want to know Christ - yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, and so, somehow, attaining to the resurrection from the dead.

Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me. Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:10-14)

I believe this is the re-framing that God is looking for in our lives, as individuals and together as His church here at Orenco. Please continue to read and re-read through Paul's letter to the Philippian congregation, and continue to pray for God's Holy Spirit to be involved in the re-framing of our own lives – all for Him and for our community!


#### Hello Friends!



the Meeting Place at the church at 8:45am.






BottleDrop is a convenient way to redeem your Oregon beverage containers and our church is a registered non-profit in their program. This means you can have your bottle return money go to the church. At 10 cents per container, this can add up.

There are two ways you can do this:

- 1. If you already have a BottleDrop account that uses the green bags, you may go online and designate part or all of your return funds to Orenco Presbyterian Church.
- 2. Pick up an empty blue Bottledrop bag and sticker at the church. Fill it with your containers and take to a BottleDrop location. Some groceries have one, including Fred Meyer on Imbrie Rd.
