Message from Pastor Mark

February 14 is Valentine's Day – traditionally a day where we think of love and what it means to love and to receive love. God's Word to us has lots to say about God's love for us, one such verse that says to us, *"Greater love has no one than this, that He lay down His life for us . . ."* (see John 15:13).

God's love for us is found in Scripture, and shown to us in a variety of ways. It's unconditional, in that we don't earn His love by how we live, nor does it diminish by what we don't do as part of His love toward us. It's also sacrificial, because God gave us His Son, that through Jesus' death and resurrection, God did all He needed to do to redeem us.

God's love is also everlasting and unchanging (*"His steadfast love endures forever"* – from Psalm 136). His love for us is constant, and it remains regardless of circumstances or feelings. God's love is also relational – He seeks us out, as expressed in the parable about the lost sheep, where the shepherd leaves the herd to seek and find that lost sheep (Luke 15:1-7). God not only loves us but He also calls us into a deeper and personal relationship, with Him and with each other.

God's love is also one that disciplines us and protects us. We read in Proverbs 3:12, *"For the Lord disciplines those He loves . . ."* We also read in James 1:2-3, *"Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance."*

May this verse we learned as children be the foundation of the relationship God has with each of us: *"For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."* That verse tells us that God so deeply loves us that He sacrificed His Son, Jesus, so anyone who believes in Him can have eternal life. It shows us His immense and boundless love, uniquely given to us through His Son. May His love offer us hope and purpose. Together, let us live for the One who died and now lives for us. Amen

The year of 2026 has started off great. The youth started this new year so far averaging 6 students a week and we have begun our lessons in the book of Matthew going over The Beatitudes. The Beatitudes show us what life looks like when God's Kingdom breaks in and turns what we think are common ideas of success upside down.

To continue our studies, the youth group will be going deeper and heavier into the importance of Scripture and the importance of knowing scripture. In the lives of our students, there are many voices both from people around them and from social media that twist Scripture to fit their own agendas. Our goal is to help students recognize when Scripture is being used incorrectly and to equip them to understand God's Word in its proper context, so they can discern truth, resist false teaching, and grow in a faith rooted in what the Bible actually says.

When he writes, “Beloved, let us love one another,” he speaks as someone who has been transformed by the love of Christ and now invites us into that same way of living. Real love is more than warm words or polite gestures; it is the evidence that God’s life is at work within us. Because love originates in Him, every act of patience, forgiveness,

or kindness becomes a small reflection of His character. And when loving others feels difficult, especially those who do not love us back, Scripture reminds us that this kind of love is supernatural, flowing from a God who loved us first. Today is an opportunity to draw from that fountainhead and allow His love to move through us in ways that heal, restore, and bear witness to the One who is Love Himself.

February is a joyful and busy month at Orenco Christian Preschool as we celebrate God’s love and look ahead to the upcoming year.

Thank you to the 30+ households who have designated Orenco Church to receive a donation for every dollar they spend at Fred Meyer! Because of you, the church receives a check every three months. Currently, the American Red Cross is facing a severe blood and platelet shortage. Requests from hospitals are exceeding the available supply, drawing down the blood supply by about 35% over the past month. Orenco Church wants to help! Church Fundraiser!

Do you know that we sell gift cards? This is a year round fundraiser for our church. Stop by our desk in the hallway after Sunday worship and we'd be happy to explain how it works. We hope you will remember us ongoing for all your shopping needs, whether it's for a gift or to use at the places you go to all the time. We offer all types of gift cards! We keep some onhand, but the best way to use this fundraiser is to place an order. You have a larger variety of cards and denominations to choose and it doesn't deplete our inventory as fast. We order once a month for our yellow form, which has cards for all kinds of places. We also order Kroger gift cards, on our blue form, when we have enough orders to meet their minimum. These may be used at Fred Meyer, QFC, or any other Kroger store or gas station in the US. Both forms are in the hallway and also on the church website: www.https://tinyurl.com/OrencoDocs.

Attention Intel Employees
