## Do I really have to repent?

All of the verses at the beginning of this lesson use the second word (to think differently). So gospel repentance is not just to feel sorry or to regret what we have done, it is to think differently and to turn away from the things we used to do.
The first is used in Matthew 27:3  Even repented. He regretted the situation he was in, but he did not get right with God.
The New Testament also has two different words for "repent". One means to care afterwards (regret) and the other means to think differently (reconsider).
God did not command to feel sorry, but to away.
Ezekiel 14:6.
The other Old Testament word that appears as "repent" means to turn away.
What does it mean to repent?  There are two Hebrew words that appear as the word, "repent" in Jeremiah 31:19.  The writer here shows that he is not much different from the rest of us; after he got caught, he felt tor what he had done wrong.
