The flowers in the sanctuary are given to the glory of God by Bill and Cindy Jarrard in loving memory of their fathers, James Thomas and Howell Jarrard.



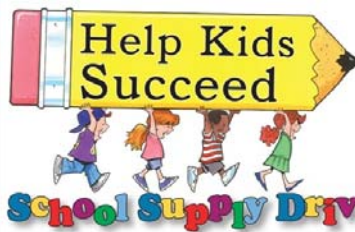

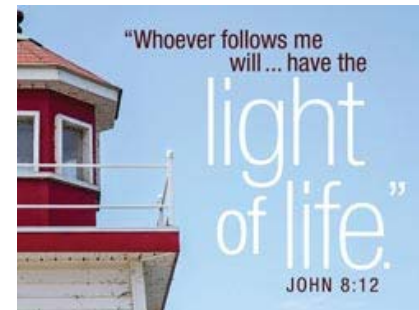
