Our Fall venture earlier this month couldn't have been better! 43 campers gathered in Hiawassee and enjoyed a weekend of beautiful weather, cooler temps, plentiful food, and outstanding fellowship. If you were unable to attend, we missed you!

Perhaps you have already heard, but the Scampers will return to Bald Mountain Park again next year (Oct 1-3, 2021). This is the weekend prior to the start of the Georgia Mountain Fall Festival and begins a peak season for the campground. Thus, they will fill up quickly as extended stay seasonal campers arrive and begin making their own reservations for next year.

If you are interested in making the Fall 2021 trip do not delay making your reservations today. Our group will be in the general area of Pine Cove Circle. A campground map is available on-line at [www.baldmountainpark.com](http://www.baldmountainpark.com). The telephone number for reservations is 706-896-8896.

**Special note to tent campers:** The Owner has identified a number of smaller RV sites in the vicinity on which tents will be permitted. When making tent camping reservations ask for one of the following site numbers: 54, 55, 56, 66, 67, 68, 69, 79, 80, 87, 88, 89, 90, or 91. For families who may require more than one tent, the campground does enforce a policy which limits occupancy to only one sleeping tent per site, so be prepared to reserve sites accordingly.

Our goal is that everyone is accommodated. The experience simply wouldn't be the same without YOU!
