Psalm 19 – “A Word Sweeter Than Honey”

Synopsis: God has revealed Himself in two primary ways: in the General Revelation of nature, and in the Special Revelation of the Bible. Redemption is made known only in Special Revelation, where we learn of the redeeming grace of God that can be ours by faith in His Son, Jesus Christ.

For Thought

1. In your opinion, what aspects of creation most clearly argue for a Creator God?

2. What can be learned about God through natural revelation (creation)?
3. According to verses 7-11, what does the Law of God do?
4. How do the effects of general revelation in vv. 1-6 differ from the effects of special revelation in vv. 7-11?

5. What result did the Law have in the Apostle Paul’s life (Rom. 7:7-14)? How about in the psalmist’s life (vv. 12-13)?
6. Why do you think he refers to the Lord as his “rock” and “redeemer” in v. 14? Has he needed a rock and redeemer in this Psalm?

Application

7. Is the Bible as valuable to you as gold or as sweet as honey? Why, or why not? How can you tell?
8. When you think of God’s law, do you consider it to be lovely and pure, or something else? Why?
9. What should you do when you find that you have disobeyed God’s Law?
