

Cover-to-Cover Bible Survey is offered at two levels: Certificate level and Diploma level.

The **Certificate Level** course is for those learners looking for a comprehensive understanding of the Bible. Certificate-level learners are expected to invest at least 6 hours of study per week, which includes:

- Reading the assigned Scriptures and workbook each week.
- Learning from the weekly lessons.
- Completing a brief lesson/book summary and tracking the Scarlet Thread of Redemption in each book. This will provide the student with an overall summary of the Bible by the end of the course.

The **Diploma Level** course is suitable for those seeking leadership roles in ministry, or who are interested in recognition for prior learning (RPL) or credit transfer at a college, university or seminary. The Diploma Level requires learners to invest at least 6-8 hours of study each week, which includes:

- Reading the Scriptures and workbook each week.
- Learning from the weekly lessons.
- Completing the book summaries and Scarlet Thread tracking each week
- **AND** writing a short essay (two to three pages) on **ONE** of the topics provided at the end of each lesson, going deeper in your study and writing.

Additional Information for Diploma Students:

- Anyone can take Cover to Cover at the Diploma level if they desire to do so. Students seeking College Credit must take the course at the Diploma level.
- Average time for Bible reading and writing assignments is 6-8 hours per week.
- To earn a diploma that leads to college credit, you will complete 14 writing assignments per semester.
- We expect the writing to be at “grade level” with an emphasis not only on content but on proper writing techniques.
- Each assignment will be graded and commented on by your teacher.
- Attendance during class is expected in order to fulfill overall credit requirements.
