



Cover-to-Cover Bible Course

Online or On Campus

Man shall not live on bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.

Village Schools of the Bible is a 32-year old Twin Cities-based discipling ministry that helps people study the entire Bible from Cover-to-Cover, and trace the unifying themes that link the Bible together. Students immerse themselves in God’s Word, and often say they’ve “never studied the Bible like this before”, and “this is life-changing!” This spiritual formation course is suitable for ages 14 and up, and can be used to fulfill a high school course or apply for university credit.

What Students Can Expect

- Instructor-led.** Students read the entire Bible from Genesis to Revelation over two semesters. Fall semester: 15 weeks in the Old Testament starting in September. Spring semester: 15 weeks in the New Testament starting in January.
- Video lessons and textbooks.** Video lessons and online textbooks help students with background information, the high points of each book of the Bible, and key themes that link the Bible together.
- Guided journaling with a mentor.** All students are expected to journal (i.e. they write each week, and a mentor provides feedback and records their grades).
- Choose your level of engagement.** Expect to spend at least one hour a day on your study.

Certificate Level - Write an online post each week in response to key questions pertaining to their Bible reading, and receive feedback from their online mentor.

Diploma Level – For students seeking to apply for college credit transfer. Assignments, writing, and end-of-year project. Earn college credits from select universities (conditions apply). Details: <http://villageschoolsofthebible.org/classes/university-credits>

- Flexibility.** Students work asynchronously (i.e. they do their work on the online learning platform whenever it suits them each week.) Anticipate at least 6 hours each week to keep pace.

Cost. \$149 per semester, with a family cap of \$249 (i.e. the cost for two or more students from the same family is \$249 per semester.) Parents may wish to take this course with their students.

Subject	Cover-to-Cover Bible Survey
Reading	Reading the entire Bible from Genesis to Revelation.
Writing	Journaling – writing reflection papers on books of the Bible.
Literature	In reading the Bible, students learn about various literary forms: Laws, History, Poetry and Songs, Wisdom sayings, Proverbs, Gospels, Letters and Apocalyptic literature. Also, reading the Bible requires understanding numerous figures of speech.
History	Historical books of the Bible include Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 1 & 2 Samuel, 1 & 2 Kings, 1 & 2 Chronicles, Ezra, Nehemiah and Esther, amongst others.
Geography	Understand the cradle of civilization and geography of the Bible.
Government	The Bible covers the formation of the nation of Israel, and teaches the responsibilities and obligations of government, and how we should relate to government.
Health	The Bible has much to say about health in the Mosaic laws. Jesus, our Great Physician, has much to teach about spiritual and relational health.
