## **DON'T SKIP THE CAMP OFFICE!**

If you're staying overnight or you're a cabin owner (staying or not), be sure to stop by the Camp Office to check in. Even if you pre-registered, we still need you to swing by—your packet and parking pass will be waiting for you! Thanks for helping us keep everything safe and organized.

## **PARKING PASSES**

All vehicles must be in designated parking areas. And yes, **every vehicle parked overnight** needs a parking permit from the Camp Office. Swing by and snag your permit!

## **MEALS**

The first meal offered for sale in the Dining Hall will be Monday breakfast. Meal tickets may be purchased at the Camp Office. See page 15 for prices.

# NEW THIS YEAR

## RV SITE WAITLIST

Good news! You no longer need to set an alarm, grab a lawn chair, and wait in line outside the Camp Office on Thursday morning to request an RV site or site change.

If you'd like an available site or would like to be considered for a different site, simply ask the **Camp Office to add your name to the RV Site Waitlist**. If a site becomes available, we'll contact campers in the order requests were received.

Don't forget: if you'd like to keep your current site, you must re-reserve it before the Camp Office closes on Wednesday. After that, unclaimed sites may be offered to campers on the waitlist.

## CAMPFIRE

Weather permitting, the campfire will be going every night. On **Tuesday and Thursday, stop by for S'Mores with CREW!**

Kits can be purchased for \$1 with all the proceeds going to future camp scholarships.

## SECURITY GATES

For the safety and security of our campers, Prairie Camp has installed new security gates at all vehicle entrances. The gates will be closed **each evening from 11:00 PM to 5:00 AM**, restricting vehicle access to the campgrounds during those hours.

If you need to leave camp during the night, you may do so at any time. Simply pull up to the gate and wait for it to open. However, vehicles will not be permitted to enter camp between 11:00 PM and 5:00 AM. Please plan accordingly if you expect to return late in the evening.

The Family Camp Kick-Off Cookout on Sunday is now a ticketed event. **Tickets are \$5 per person** ages 6 and up. Children 5 and under are free. Stop by the Camp Office to purchase your tickets.

# CAMP RULES

READ 'EM, KNOW 'EM, KEEP CAMP AWESOME.

## REGISTRATION & ATTENDANCE

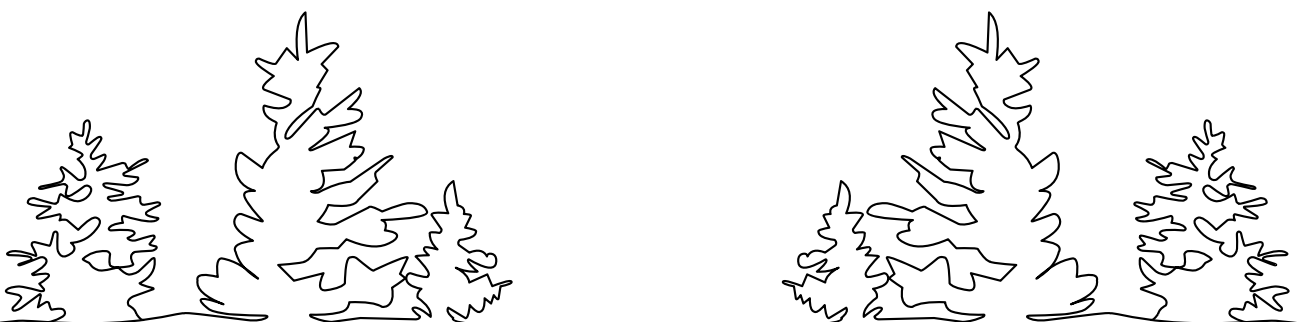
- **All overnight campers and cabin owners** must register either online or at the Camp Office.
- All campers are expected to attend scheduled activities and services.

## VEHICLES & PARKING

- All vehicles parked **overnight** must display a **permit**—pick one up at the Camp Office.
- The speed limit on camp grounds is **5 mph**—safety first!
- Small motorized vehicles (like golf carts) are for camp staff and those with handicapped/elderly permits only. Permits available at the Camp Office.
- **Bikes, skateboards, hoverboards, etc. are not allowed on camp grounds.**

## KIDS & TEENS

- You must be 19 years old and out of high school for at least one year to stay on the grounds without a parent.
- Children must be supervised at all times and are not allowed on the playground during services.
- **Family Camp is designed for the whole family**—please help us keep everyone safe by knowing where your teenagers are at all times.



# CAMP RULES

JUST A FEW MORE...

## SAFETY & CONDUCT

- Shoes must be worn outside at all times.
- Campfires are allowed only in approved containers and must be off the ground.
- The playground is for children through 5th grade only.
- **Everyone must be at their own cabin or RV site by 11:30 p.m.**
- Prairie Camp is not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken personal property.

## FACILITIES

- **Please use the dumpsters behind the Dining Hall for all trash.**
  - *If dumpsters are full, **do not leave trash on the ground**—take it back and return later.*
  - **Large items like furniture and appliances may not be placed in the dumpster.** *It is your responsibility to remove these from camp.*
- No wastewater is to be dumped on the ground.
- **All damage, no matter the size, must be reported to the Camp Office or Camp Director.**
- No posting of signs without permission from the Camp Director.

## PROHIBITED

- The following are strictly prohibited:
  - Alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms or weapons, explosives, and foul language.
- **PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON CAMP GROUNDS.**

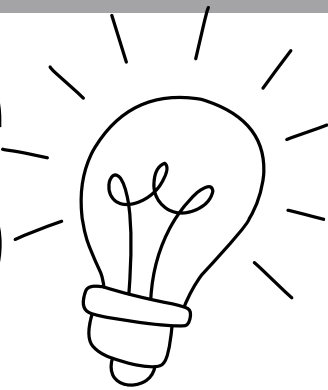


## HEAR YE, HEAR YE!

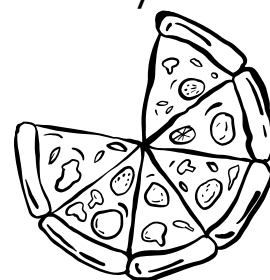

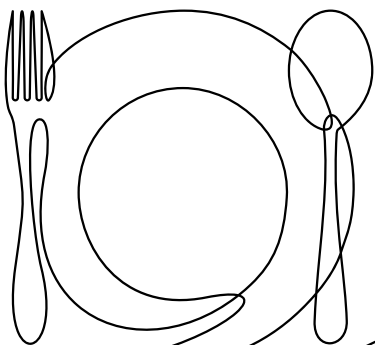

# CABINS & RVS

## CABINS

- Please park your vehicle in the designated parking areas, unless you have plenty of room by your cabin.
- ALL vehicles that are parked overnight on the grounds will need a Parking Permit issued by the Camp Office and your vehicle must not block any traffic lane at any time.
- We would like to use your cabin! If you could make it available for other rental groups, please let us know at the Camp Office or email [Michelle@mcncr.org](mailto:Michelle@mcncr.org). You will receive 50% of income received from the use.
- Cabin fees for 2027 will be: **Old Section—\$375 | New Section—\$525**. This includes AC and accounts for rising utility costs.



## RVS

- Be sure your camper is completely contained within your site.
- Do not park your vehicles on a site beside you. There may be campers coming in late at night or later in the week.
- All holding tanks may be emptied at the dumping station on the south end of the camp by the ball diamond at no charge. You can also pay for on-site **dumping scheduled for Wednesday**. The cost is \$30. Sign up at the Camp Office.
- If you would like to reserve the site you are on for next year, you may do so until **Wednesday, July 16**, before the Camp Office closes for the day or at [PrairieCamp.org](http://PrairieCamp.org). Beginning Thursday morning, any site not reserved may be reserved by someone else.
  - **RV sites for 2026 will be**
    - **30 amp sites - \$300**
    - **50 amp sites - \$350**
- RV Cancellation Policy: All but \$25 will be refunded to you if cancellation occurs before June 1, 2026. After June 1, there are no refunds.
- **All RVs must be removed from camp by 5:00 p.m. Saturday, July 25. A \$25 per day storage fee may be charged for all RVs not removed.**

*The required deposit is \$150 to reserve your site, with the balance due by June 1, 2027.*



# STORM SHELTERS & EMERGENCIES

## STORM SHELTERS

In the event of severe weather, everyone should seek shelter in the area designated on the map on the next page. Please familiarize yourself with the areas.

If there is time, we will ring the bell continuously, as long as it's safe to do so. If you are in the tabernacle, and a tornado is imminent, turn the benches over and get under them. Remain in your shelter until an all clear is given.

## MEDICAL EMERGENCY

When a medical emergency occurs, send someone to the Nurse's Office to use the walkie talkie or cell phone provided to contact the nurse on duty. Instructions are in the Nurse's Office.

In a non-emergency situation, it is the responsibility of the Camp Director or Camp Nurse to determine the course of action in contacting a doctor and the parents (if applicable).

## FIRE EMERGENCY

Evacuate the building immediately and yell "FIRE!!" Do not enter a smoke-filled building! If you are evacuated from a building, go to the ball diamond or empty field west of the gym so that all can be accounted for. Stay there until the all clear is given.

If the fire is small and well confined, an attempt can be made to put it out with the fire extinguisher.

In all cases, call the fire department and contact the Camp Director, Ben Hahn.

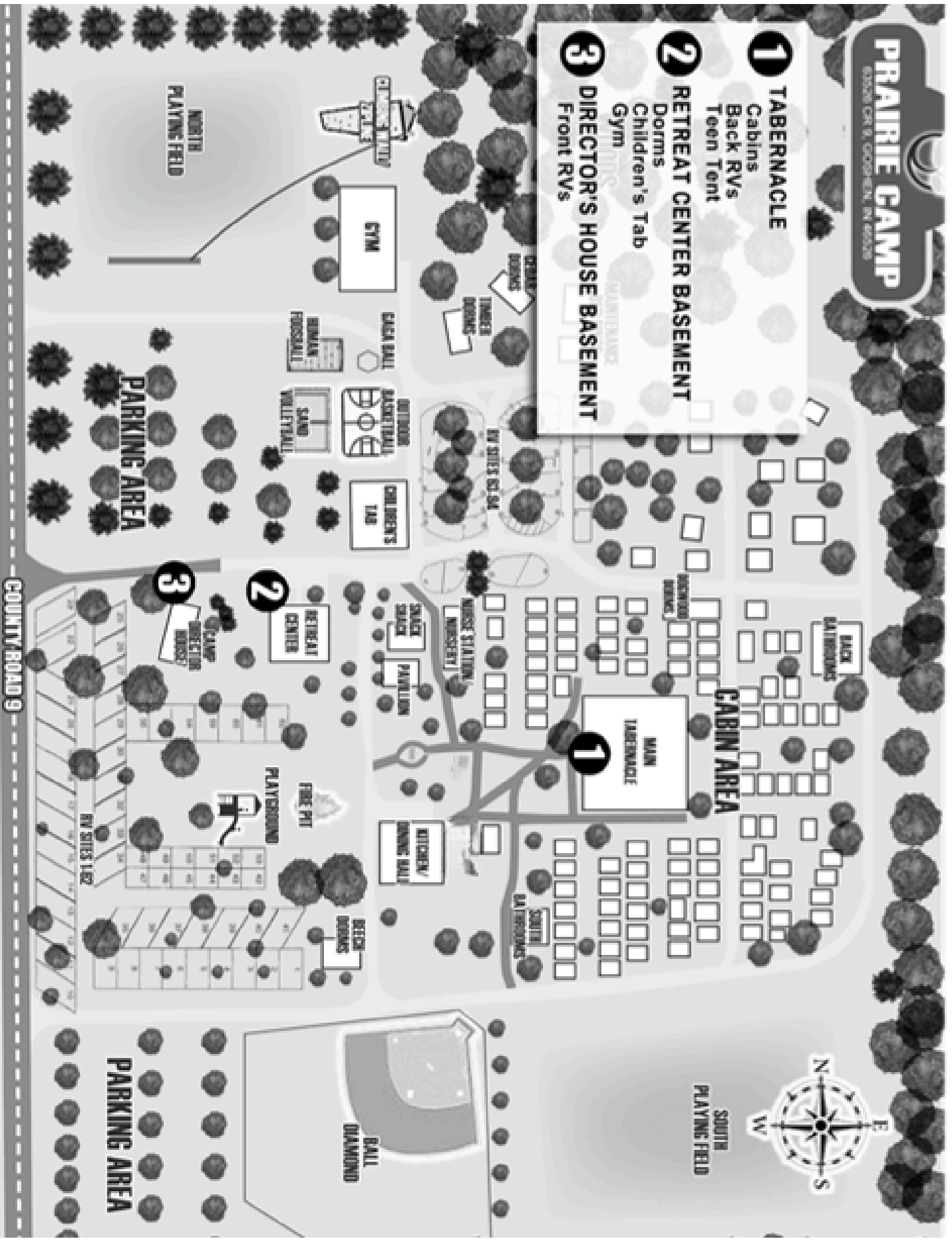
