Thoughts from Pastor Jay

I know we might get distracted by the abundance of eggs, bunnies and chocolate at Easter, but we know Easter is really about the resurrection of Jesus. Christians around the world celebrate an empty tomb and a risen Savior at Easter.

The question I want us to consider today is: once Easter is over, what happens next? Any time there is a major holiday or celebration, there comes a moment when everyone has to go back to their normal lives. That's how things work.

Even the followers of Jesus, who were there at the time of His resurrection, had to figure out what to do next. They had to decide how they were going to live in light of the fact that Jesus had risen from the dead. For them, the problem was that Jesus didn't stick around long. After 40 days Jesus ascended into heaven and left His followers on their own.

Thankfully, He did leave some instructions, a model to live by, and the Holy Spirit. And while not perfect, those early followers did their best to fulfill Christ's mission. As a result, there are Christians around the globe following Jesus today.

For us, we need to consider how we will live, in light of Jesus' resurrection. Whenever we go through a significant moment in life, we have the opportunity to change and grow. Sometimes that happens without any effort; we are so impacted, we naturally change. Other times we have to consciously make an effort to change. Either way, life's significant moments can positively shape our lives and Easter is one of those moments!

Today I encourage you to consider how you are living in light of the resurrection. Remember that Jesus came to give us life and that life happens when we live for Him!

This year, let Easter make an impact on your life beyond the weekend, as you experience the life our Savior offers us!
