Living for Jesus - Thoughts from Pastor Monte

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding; in all your ways know him, and he will make your paths straight." — Proverbs 3:5-6

These frequently quoted verses can, in a few short lines, sum up what it means to live as a follower of Jesus Christ. While John 3:16 declares the gospel, Proverbs 3:5-6 directs us on how to live in the freedom offered to us through the gospel. Through Jesus, God has given us the opportunity to experience not only freedom from sin, but also the freedom to experience a life full of hope, joy, and purpose. Proverbs 3:5-6 reminds us that the path to a full life is not focused on the pursuit of pleasure—as our own understanding would tell us—but rather on seeking God's will for our daily lives.

The creation account tells us that we are made in the image of God. This means that as image-bearers, life will always feel lacking unless we are pursuing the heart of God. As image-bearers, we are called to reflect and represent God's holiness, love, grace, and mercy in all that we do—especially in what many would consider the mundane happenings of our lives.

It is actually those who are faithful in the small, seemingly unnoticeable details of life who make the biggest impacts for the kingdom of God and the advancement of the gospel. The truth is, we are always being watched by someone—a child, co-worker, friend, neighbour, or spouse. When they witness a faithful desire to know God and live according to His Word, it testifies not just to your love for God, but also to His love for you. Your life will stand out, it will be noticed, and it will impact those around you as a testimony to the transformative power of God's love.

So, I encourage you today to not just focus on the "big" things God calls us to, but to instead focus on the day-to-day things. Lean into who He is, and let the Holy Spirit guide you in your life. If you do, you will find love, joy, peace, and purpose, and you will also help others find them as well.
