

God is in the crazy

Thoughts from Pastor Monte

The author of Ecclesiastes famously wrote in chapter three that "there is an occasion for everything and a time for every activity under heaven." Time is an interesting thing; there are seasons where we never seem to have enough and others where it seems to drag. One thing I have noticed in life is that the older I get the faster time seems to pass me by. When I was in elementary school summers seemed to go on forever, it was glorious! Now June arrives, I blink and it seems fall has come.

For many of us September comes with an increase in our pace of life. Kids going back to school, sports teams starting up again, care groups and Bible studies, the list can go on and on. It can be easy to find, against our best intentions, that God ends up taking a back seat to the increased demands in our lives. I just want to encourage you today with a few thoughts when it comes to spending time with God in the crazy busy seasons.

Firstly, God understands. I will say that again, God understands! He is a God of grace, mercy and compassion. Do not let the enemy or even well-meaning Christians put guilt on you that you are not doing enough for Him. Remember, we can never do enough, but Jesus is enough. That is the power of the Gospel. Jesus is enough and that is all we need. Yes, we do all we can to serve Him and be with Him, but give yourself the grace He gives you.

Secondly, while you may not be able to spend the focused time one on one with God for a season, you can still include Him in the "moments." What I mean by moments are things like singing praise while driving, pausing for a quick word of prayer between events, stopping to take a deep breath and simply asking Him to speak. The key is just to focus your mind even briefly on the fact that He is with you and I promise you will find His presence in the middle of the crazy.

God understands the demands of your life, He loves you and desires to just be with you throughout your day. Ephesians 4:32 says "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving one another, just as God also forgave you in Christ." Sometimes the person you need to be the most compassionate with is yourself.
