

General Camp Regulations

Indian Hills Camp

Thank you for choosing Indian Hills Camp. These guidelines have been developed for the enjoyment of all our guests. We appreciate your taking the time to review them with your entire group before arrival.

- 1. Check in time is 3:00-7:00 p.m. on Friday, or anytime 9am-5pm for Day Use on Saturday. Camp closes at 12:00 noon on Sunday.**
- 2. Please do not venture off the camp property. Trespassing is not appreciated by our neighbors and places strain on the camp's relationship with them. This must be strongly emphasized at night.**
- 3. Alcoholic beverages, Marijuana, and illegal drugs of any kind are not allowed on the camp property.**
- 4. Smoking & vaping are NOT permitted on camp property.**
- 5. We welcome your pets as long as they do not go inside any buildings. Please keep them on a leash at all times, and picked up after.**
- 6. Off-road vehicles or motorbikes (including, but not limited to: motorbikes, ATVs, golf carts) are NOT allowed on camp property.**
- 7. QUIET HOURS are between 10:30 p.m. and 7:30 a.m. The playground is off limits during these hours.**
- 8. When constructing campfires, use only provided fire pits. Clearance area should be clear of weeds, leaves, and other debris. Do not dump ashes. Put out fires completely with water after use. Do NOT allow children to use matches or lighters unattended.**
- 9. No firearms, pellet or BB guns are allowed on the camp or adjacent properties. Bows and arrows (no broad heads or compound bows) may be used only at the archery range while a staff member is present.**
- 10. Please avoid the cutting or marring of trees.**
- 11. An adult must be present with children under 14 at the farmyard, pool, bike track and playground.**
- 12. The camp speed limit is 10 mph. Remember to watch for children crossing roads and bridges around camp.**
- 13. Keep amplified music to a minimum. Please contact the office prior to use. Sound carries a long way in our peaceful valley. Amplified music MUST be turned off by 9pm.**
- 14. Bicycles-Please use caution on roadways. HELMETS are MANDATORY, for children under the age of 18, and are to be worn at all times while riding on camp.**
- 15. The group leader will inform the IHC office of any injuries incurred on camp.**
