Suggestions to Celebrate these Milestones

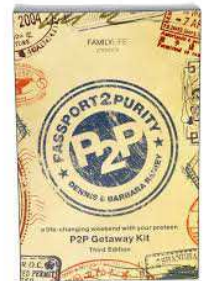
- Plan a *Passport to Purity* weekend retreat

Goals for this Age

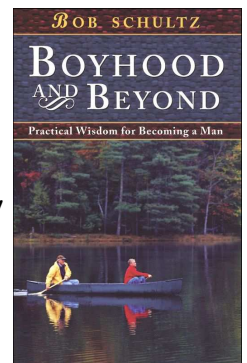
- Be a part of service event w/family
