The **Milestone of Dedication** is an important one in the life of the child, the family and the church.

In this ceremony parents bring their child before the church for three primary reasons:

Suggestions to Celebrate this Milestone

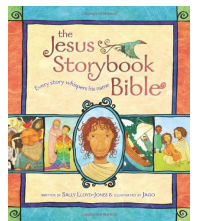
- Invite as many family and friends you can think of to the service

- Create Family Mission Statement

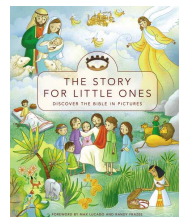
