




Setting Our Hope curriculum is utilized in our Pre-K, K-1st Grade, 2nd-3rd Grade, 4th-5th Grade and 6th-8th Grade classrooms. Based on the ideas of Psalm 78:1-8, it is structured to systematically lead and teach children of The Orchard core Biblical and doctrinal truths of the Christian faith. Each of the nine quarters lasts approximately 12 weeks and is focused on a specific doctrine.

Lessons are supported by a weekly ***Family Plan*** that is sent home. This is designed to give parents a tool to help lead children through short teaching moments each day. It helps reinforce to your children that what they learned from Scripture on Sunday is real, important and true. It also gives parents a tool to help disciple their children as you seek to raise them in the grace and knowledge of our Lord. The ***Family Plan*** for the week and the weekly verse that are sent home are the same for each class level so families with more than one child can use them for devotional time more effectively. There is also a link on our webpage that is updated weekly so you can download the ***Family Plan*** if you miss a Sunday.

The complete list of quarters include:

Doctrine of God, The Bible, Doctrine of Jesus Christ, Doctrine of Sin and Salvation, God's Promises, Doctrine of the Holy Spirit, The Church, The Ten Commandments, Missions, and How to Study Your Bible.



Additionally, at the completion of the nine quarters of **Setting Our Hope**, we transition into three quarters of **The Story**. This teaching begins at Genesis and moves through the Scriptures to Revelation. Each week's lesson is accompanied by a short 5 minute entertaining video before diving into the teaching for the week. ***Family Plans*** are still provided to assist parents in teaching and reinforcing the lessons at home.
