Join us as we study Scripture together! This reading plan works alongside our Genesis 1-3 sermon series. Each week we'll read the sermon passage three times in preparation for our Sunday gathering. We'll also read the long and sorrowful book of Job where we come face to face with two important biblical themes that are also emphasized in the opening of Genesis. First, we'll see the drastic effects of the fall and the ways God's people continue to suffer at the hands of the Serpent. Second, like Genesis, Job highlights God as the sovereign creative king of the cosmos.

From the New Testament we will read Romans. One of the major themes we see in this letter, like in Genesis 1-11, is that the heart of the gospel was designed all the way at the beginning of the Bible's story. Christ is our new Adam who brings us back to the garden, rescuing us from the first man's fall. Finally, we'll continue our slow read through Luke as we meditate on the person and personality of Jesus.
