Leadership

Elder

The Greek word *presbyteros* is the same for **elder**, **shepherd**, **or overseer**. We recognize the roles of pastor and elder as one and the same (although some elders are vocational, or paid). Elders are responsible for the oversight of all matters of church life and practice (Acts 14:23, 20:28). Elders must be qualified according to the biblical standards of 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:5-9. Elders are to serve the body willingly, eagerly, exemplary and humbly, modeling Christ's sacrificial, servant leadership in love (1 Peter 5:1-5). While an elder is qualified until they are biblically unqualified or choose to resign, each elder (except pastoral staff) serves a three-year term on the active board and may serve a second consecutive three-year term if desired, followed by a one-year break.

If you answer "no" for any of the elder or deacon nominees, we ask that you offer an explanation. There will be space for that at the bottom of this form.

Deacons assist the elders, allowing the elders to focus on the ministry of the Word and prayer (<u>Acts 6:1-7</u>). They focus on areas like facilities, finances, and member care. Deacons must be qualified according to the biblical standards of <u>1 Timothy 3:8-13</u>

By-Law Change

Old Wording:

Article V. Section 2

Members are expected to be faithful in all spiritual duties essential to the Christian life, to participate in communion ordinances, to be loyal to the church, to attend regularly its services, to contribute to its support and charities, and to share in its organized work.

New Wording:

Article V. Section 2

Membership Duties

Members are expected to actively pursue growth as a disciple of Jesus, faithfully attend Sunday morning services, serve this body, give to it generously, meaningfully engage in its community, and participate in congregational meetings and decisions.
