This Chromebook will be used for academic purposes only and should last throughout their time at Atonement. While this Chromebook is yours, ALS will manage and monitor access through our firewall to the Internet and anything outside of the school network while your child is on campus. This is to keep your child(ren) safe while using this technology. You will be asked to sign a “Chromebook and Technology Acceptable Use Form” before the first day of school. Please be aware there will also be a technology fee charged to your account. This fee covers programs and licensing costs.

We suggest purchasing the Chromebook for your student at Best Buy, or somewhere similar, so that you have access to tech support for issues that may arise, or damages incurred. We highly recommend a warranty.
