CONFIRMATION

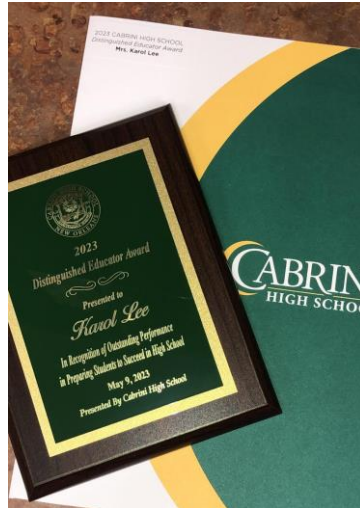
Congratulations to the Confirmation Class of 2023 who were confirmed on Sunday!
