Are people's donations tax deductible?

Yes. Make sure checks are made out to terranova instead of you personally. They can note your name on the memo with Honduras.

Do I need a PASSPORT?

How to I hold my spot on the team?

\$50 deposit is due to secure your spot. You can either drop in the giving box at church (with Honduras deposit in memo of check), or mail: P.O. Box 2191 Georgetown, TX 78627

What's the cost of the trip?

\$1,250. If you are an active terranovan, we will defray the cost by \$500 – leaving you with \$750 to raise per person. If you are a guest we will defray the cost by \$250, leaving you with \$1,000 to raise.

This will cover all expenses except for snacks and souvenirs.

If your entire family would like to go, additional help might be available.

How do I learn how to raise support?

What are the Deadlines?

Nov 20th – 50% of Trip cost Due (\$375), all non-refundable, deposit counts towards it (total due will be \$325).

Dec 18th – Remaining balance due (\$375).

Are there any meetings required before the trip?

YES! There will be 2 mandatory meetings before the trip, all at 12:15 at the WBA after church. Bring your lunch and we'll meet for an hour or so. There will also be optional meetings in December to focus on prayer, or other specifics.

Do I have to know Spanish?

Will we have internet/phone access?

We will have very limited internet access, but it is possible.

How old do I have to be?

To go without a parent you must have completed 9th grade and have parent permission.

What are the sleeping conditions?

What kind of work will we be doing?

We have "adopted" the small high mountain village of Las Mercedes. We will be involved in distributing bibles, playing soccer with kids, hosting vacation bible school, distributing back packs, and also going out to another unreached village... as well as helping wherever else opportunity lends itself. Flexibility will play a key role!

YES! We're taking another trip next Summer!

We plan on taking 2 trips per year to Las Mercedes for years to come!
