#### WHAT IS STUDENT PARKING?

Regeneration Church welcomes the opportunity to share its facilities with the community. We are, therefore, pleased to offer Eastlake High School students the privilege of parking at Regeneration Church for school commuting. Space is limited and available until all permits are assigned.

Eastlake students who wish to park at Regeneration Church for school commuting purposes must apply for a Regeneration Church Student Parking Permit. Permits are available yearly or quarterly. Students who are issued a Parking Permit are required to pay a \$75 (quarterly) or \$200 (yearly) non-refundable fee with Application. Please scan and email completed applications to [parking@regenerationclb.org](mailto:parking@regenerationclb.org) or drop completed application into the mail box by the front door of the church. Alternatively call 425.868.6879 to schedule a time to pick up.

All forms need to be completed when applying and in addition to copies of:

- Driver's License
- Vehicle registration [for each vehicle]
- Proof of insurance [for each vehicle]

Eastlake Students who park on Regeneration Church property for the purpose of school commuting, must have a valid Regeneration Church Student Parking Permit. Students will allowed to park in the spots along 233<sup>rd</sup> Ave and in the spaces between the light posts furthest from the church. Limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. In exchange for the parking privilege, Eastlake Students agree to: 1) Pay a non-refundable \$75 fee for every 3-month period or a onetime fee of \$200 for Sep-June. Payments can be made via check or online at <https://regeneration-church.square.site/product/regeneration-church-parking-lot-space-rental/3?cs=true> 2) Respect the church and others persons and abide the rules as outlined in this agreement.

#### Instructions:

1. Application must be completed and signed by the student and a parent / legal guardian.
2. Non-refundable fee must be submitted with the application (or online prior).
3. Agreement and Waiver forms must be signed and attached.
4. ATTACH ONE COPY EACH OF: STUDENT'S DRIVERS LICENSE, VALID AUTOMOBILE REGISTRATION AND PROOF OF VALID AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE POLICY FOR EACH AUTO (UP TO 2) STUDENT WILL BE DRIVING.

6. Receive permit by email.
7. Display permit on dash when parked at Regeneration Church.

#### Regeneration Church STUDENT PARKING POLICIES:

- Student must maintain current information on file with Regeneration Church.
- Students must park in the spaces along 233<sup>rd</sup> or in the spots between the streetlights furthest from the church building.
- Regeneration Student Parking Permit must be face up and clearly visible through the front window of the car.
- If it is not clearly visible, a warning will be issued. Repeat violators may have their car towed at the owner's expense and may forfeit parking privileges.
- If the license number of the car does not match the license number of the permit, a warning will be issued. Repeat violators may have their car towed at the owner's expense and may forfeit parking privileges.
- Students assume responsibility for keeping the area around their vehicle clean. Any paper, restaurant or food debris found near their vehicle will be considered a first offense. (Note: All cars parked near the debris will be tagged with a warning.) A second offense may result in the revocation of the Regeneration Church Student Parking Permit and/or towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense.
- Regeneration Church does not assume responsibility for property theft or damage to vehicles. Students must report theft, accident, or vandalism to local law enforcement authorities.
- Lost permits may be replaced for \$20. A lost permit must be reported to [info@regenerationclb.org](mailto:info@regenerationclb.org).
- Church officials are neither qualified nor trained to assist students in gaining access to their car or in its maintenance.
- Regeneration Church reserves the right to temporarily suspend parking privileges when a church event requires full use of the parking lot. Should such an occasion arise, Regeneration Church will place a written notice on the windshield of student automobiles in advance.

#### DRIVING ON OR ABOUT REGENERATION CHURCH PROPERTY:

- Obey all Washington State traffic laws; failure to do so may result in immediate revocation of the Regeneration Church Student Parking Permit.
- The MAXIMUM speed in the church parking lot is 10 MPH and will be strictly enforced.
- Obey all entrance, exit and directional markings.
- Speeding, reckless driving, or endangerment in the Regeneration Church parking lot or on adjacent streets may result in revocation of the Regeneration Church Parking Permit and citation by local law enforcement authorities.
- Parking without the assigned Regeneration Church Student Parking Permit is subject to towing at the owner's expense and forfeiture of parking privileges.
- Violation of these rules will result in a student warning, possible revocation of permit and/or towing of vehicle at the owner's expense.



**CONSEQUENCES OF MISUSE OR ABUSE OF PARKING PRIVILEGES:**

As previously stated, the potential consequences for violation of the rules established by this agreement include the revocation of your parking permit, revocation of any future parking privileges at Regeneration Church, towing of your vehicle at your expense, and a citation issued by the Sammamish Police Department. In other words, the congregation is happy to share the lot with you, but this is a privilege which, if abused, has serious consequences.

**STUDENT PARKING PERMIT AGREEMENT**

We have read and agree to abide by the Student Parking Permit policies and regulations as set forth by Regeneration Church. We understand that failure to abide by these policies and regulations will result in consequences which may include, but are not limited to, those stated in "consequences" in above section. We agree that the Student will pay a non-refundable fee of \$75 or \$200 (due with application).

RELEASE, WAIVER & INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

The undersigned parent/legal guardian represents that he/she/they has read this Release, has requested and has been provided with, or has requested and declined advisement on the potential dangers/risks of engaging in the observation, activities or instruction offered, assumes all risks associated with such dangers and risks, and is fully aware of and understands the terms and legal consequences of the signing of this Release. The undersigned parent/legal guardian intends his/her/their signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law. If any portion of the Release is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
