Sermon Galatians: Our Charter of Freedom:

Law and Freedom, Part 2

Galatians 2:11-21 CSB

What is the relationship between acceptance with God and the life of faith that follows from that acceptance?

1 Corinthians 1:23

²¹ For since, in God's wisdom, the world did not know God through wisdom, God was pleased to save those who believe through the foolishness of what is preached.

Acceptance with God comes from a simple act of trust in Jesus Christ and not through anything else.

Galatians 2:15-21

¹⁵ We are Jews by birth and not "Gentile sinners," ¹⁶ and yet because we know that a person is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we ourselves have believed in Christ Jesus. This was so that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no human being will be justified. ¹⁷ But if we ourselves are also found to be "sinners" while seeking to be justified by Christ, is Christ then a promoter of sin? Absolutely not! ¹⁸ If I rebuild those things that I tore down, I show myself to be a lawbreaker. ¹⁹ For through the law I died to the law, so that I might live for God. ²⁰ I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave

himself for me. ²¹ I do not set aside the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the law, then Christ died for nothing.

- “Jews by birth” is contrasted with “Gentile sinners,” verse 15.
- “Justification by observing the law” is contrasted with “justification by faith in Christ,” verse 16.
- “Rebuilding the old structures of salvation is contrasted with their “destruction by the gospel,” verse 18.
- “Dying to the Law is contrasted with “living for God,” verse 19.

Salvation is either by grace alone or there is no salvation at all.

Galatians 2:15

¹⁵ We are Jews by birth and not “Gentile sinners,”

Ephesians 2:11-12

¹¹ So, then, remember that at one time you were Gentiles in the flesh—called “the uncircumcised” by those called “the circumcised,” which is done in the flesh by human hands.

¹² At that time you were without Christ, excluded from the citizenship of Israel, and foreigners to the covenants of promise, without hope and without God in the world.

Galatians 2:16

1. Justified/Justification

“The declaration that somebody is right.”

In spite of the fact that my conscience accuses me that I have grievously sinned against all the commandments of God, and have not kept any one of them, and that I am still ever prone to all that is evil, nevertheless, God, without any merit of my own, out of pure grace, grants me the benefits of the perfect expiation of Christ, imputing to me his righteousness and holiness as if I had never committed a single sin or had ever been sinful, having fulfilled myself all the obedience which Christ has carried out for me, if only I accept such favor with a trusting heart. (Heidelberg Catechism, Question 60)

2.Works of the law

Galatians 2.16

...This was so that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no human being will be justified.

No human deeds, however well motivated and sincerely performed, can ever achieve the kind of standing before God that results in the verdict of justification.

3.Faith in Christ

Ephesians 2.8-9

⁸For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God's gift—⁹not from works, so that no one can boast.
