

Church Involvement Agreement

Fairfield Christian School requires its families to be actively involved in a local church, and this information is submitted in the student's online application. Please understand, this is not an attempt to "control" our families, or even to equate spirituality with church attendance. Rather, we've found that when both school and parents share and practice similar foundational, Biblical values, the atmosphere on our campus is radically different than many other schools, the behavior of our students is different, and the quality of our academic instruction improves.

Our time-tested philosophy can be best illustrated by a simple, three-legged stool. Each leg represents a separate entity that is highly influential in a child's life: home, church and school. If any one of the three is missing or becomes unstable, the stool, or child, becomes imbalanced and may eventually topple. We believe it is absolutely crucial that every child have the needed benefit of a secure home (regardless of its composition), a quality school and a life-giving church.

To protect the spiritual integrity of our campus, and to honor our promise to all of our families, we may periodically check in with your church to ensure that your children are regularly involved and receiving spiritual instruction.
