Matthew 11:28

- 4 Enter his gates with thanksgiving; go into his courts with praise.

Holiness - Week ending January 12

Hebrews 12:14

14 Work at living in peace with everyone, and work at living a holy life, for those who are not holy will not see the Lord.

The Holy Spirit - Week ending January 19

John 14:16-17

16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you. 17 He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all truth. Romans 10:9-10

Romans 5:7-8

Jesus' Death - Week ending March 8

1 Peter 3:18

18 Christ suffered for our sins once for all time. He never sinned, but he died for sinners to bring you safely home to God. He suffered physical death, but he was raised to life in the Spirit.

The Plan of Salvation - Week ending March 22

Ephesians 2:8-9

8 God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. 9 Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it.

Self-Control - Week ending April 12

2 Peter 1:5-6

5 In view of all this, make every effort to respond to God's promises. Supplement your faith with a generous provision of moral excellence, and moral excellence with knowledge, 6 and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with patient endurance, and patient endurance with godliness, 7 and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love for everyone.

Temptation - Week ending April 19

Hebrews 2:18

18 Since He himself has gone through suffering and testing, He is able to help us when we are being tested.

Truth - Week ending April 26

John 16:13

13 When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what He has heard. He will tell you about the future.

1 Thessalonians 4:11-12
