| February 26 | John 3:16–17  | "For God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son..."                                |
| March 5     | John 6:35     | "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry again."                             |

| May 21 | Philippians 2:3–5  | "Don't be selfish... Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had." |
