### **Steadfast:**

**James 1:12**

**Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.**

### **Quarter 1: Jude Verses 20-25**

**Aug 22 V20** But you, dear friends, by building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit,

**Aug 29 V21** keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life.

**Sept 5 V22** Be merciful to those who doubt;

**Sept 12 V23** save others by snatching them from the fire; to others show mercy, mixed with fear—hating even the clothing stained by corrupted flesh.

**Sept 19 V24** To him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy—

**Sept 26 V25** to the only God our Savior be glory, majesty, power and authority, through Jesus Christ our Lord, before all ages, now and forevermore! Amen.

**Oct 3 V20-25**

### **Quarter 2: James 1:2-8**

**Oct 17 V2** Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds,

**Oct 24 V3** because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance.

**Oct 31 V4** Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

**Nov 7 V5** If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.

**Nov 14 V6** But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.

**Nov 21 V7** That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord.

**Dec 5 V8** Such a person is double-minded and unstable in all they do.

**Dec 13 V2-8**

### **Quarter 3: 1 Peter 3:8-17**

**Jan 9 V8** Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble.

**Jan 16 V9** Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult. On the contrary, repay evil with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing.

**Jan 23 V10** For, "Whoever would love life and see good days must keep their tongue from evil and their lips from deceitful speech.

**Jan 30 V11** They must turn from evil and do good; they must seek peace and pursue it.

**Feb 6 V12** For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their prayer, but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil."

**Feb 13 V13** Who is going to harm you if you are eager to do good?

**Feb 27 V14** But even if you should suffer for what is right, you are blessed. "Do not fear their threats; do not be frightened."

**Mar 6 V15** But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect,

**Mar 13 V16** keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.

**Mar 20 V17** For it is better, if it is God's will, to suffer for doing good than for doing evil.

**Mar 27 V8-17**

### **Quarter 4: 1 John 1:5-9**

**Apr 17 V5** This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all.

**Apr 24 V6** If we claim to have fellowship with him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live out the truth.

**May 1 V7** But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

**May 8 V8-9** If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

**May 15 V5-9**
