

Week 19 Sermon, January 28, 2024 Hebrews 7:20-28– *Perfect Forever*

Discussion Questions

1.	The term <i>oath</i> is used four times in our passage this week. Think about what the word
	means. Why is it actually unnecessary for God to make an oath? The author of Hebrews
	includes part of Psalm 110:4. In this instance, why does he stop the reference with, "You
	are a priest forever" (v. 21). To whom is God speaking?

- 2. Besides His permanence, what are the other characteristics of our High Priest? (See v. 26, chapter 1:10-12 and 4:14-15.) How does the knowledge that He is our Immortal Intercessor give you confidence? What does Paul say in Romans 8: 33-34 and John in 1 John 2:1?
- 3. Read v. 25 aloud together. Meditate on what it means that Jesus is "able to save to the uttermost." Who may lay claim to this secure salvation? How can this verse, along with 5:9, Isaiah 53:11-12, and John 6:44, help you in a discussion with someone who claims Jesus died for every sinner?
- 4. C.H. Spurgeon writes, "If you will not accept this Christ, there will never be another; and if you will not be saved by His redemption, you will never be redeemed at all." Who accomplishes our redemption? What do Ezekiel 11: 19-20 and John 6:37-39 say about this work?
- 5. Christ is both the Priest and the offering Who gave Himself "once for all". He is the all-sufficient sacrifice appointed by God. What do we read later in Hebrews 10:12&14? How are you being sanctified in this season? Thank God for His sanctifying work in your life and seek prayer for your weakness.
