

## PRINTABLE CRAFT



### **MATERIALS**:

- 3 Colors of Card Stock (we used green, light pink, dark pink)
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Ribbon or String
- Marker





## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Print your templates! Each child will need one card template, one row of petals, and a cross stem as shown.
- 2. Cut your templates! Have kids cut out the card, petals, and stem on the dark bold lines as shown.
- 3. Paste your stem onto the card as shown with a glue stick.
- 4. Paste the petal with a set of "v-shaped" dashed lines as shown on the card.
- 5. Fold the remaining 2 petals in half along the line down the center.
- 6. Paste these petals as shown along the v-shaped dashed lines. The idea is for the petals to create a 3D look.
- 7. Have children write their name after the "Love," on the card and fold the card along the light grey lines.
- 8. Use a pretty ribbon to tie around the "bouquet".
