

FUN ACTIVITIES FOR WEEK OF MARCH 29

CREATION

- Day 1 **LIGHT:** Trace your shadow outside with sidewalk chalk. Talk about light and dark.
- Day 2. **SKY:** Lay on grass and look for cloud shapes. Make cloud in a jar. Materials: warm, not boiling, water. Jar with a lid. Ice cubes. Aerosol hair spray. 1) Pour warm water into jar & swirl around to warm up jar. 2). Turn lid upside down & place several ice cubes on top of it. Place lid on jar. 3). Quickly remove lid, give a quick spray of aerosol hair spray. Replace lid. 4) Remove lid & watch cloud escape.
- Day 3. **DRY LAND, SEAS, PLANTS, TREES:** Go on a nature hunt. Cut open fruits with seeds & talk about what helps seeds grow.
- Day 4. **SUN, MOON, STARS:** Make moon sand. Materials: 8 cups flour, 1 cup oil (vegetable or baby), food coloring or tempera paints. Mix together and have fun.
- Day 5. **CREATURES THAT LIVE IN SEA AND CREATURES THAT FLY :** Go bird watching and discuss the different kinds of birds.
- DAY 6: ANIMALS ON LAND AND HUMAN:** Play veterinarian with stuffed animals. Use stuffed or toy plastic animals to talk about different animal classifications.
- DAY 7: RESTED:** Take a nap or sit quietly & listen to Christian music.

EXTRA ACTIVITIES:

- 1). Name as many animals and plants as they can in a given time. Choose favorite plant and favorite animal to make with clay.
- 2) Give your child a number 1-7. They must draw or act out what God created that day. Or take turns pantomiming a day and others must guess number of day that goes with.
