

Wesley LEAD Covenant

Being a part of leadership in the Body of Christ is an honor and a privilege. In the Bible, God asks leaders to lead by their example. At Wesley, we are committed to living with moral and ethical values that are consistent with the Bible and appropriate for the community we live in. We expect the students who lead at Wesley to join the staff in living according to these values as we pursue the character of Christ together.

By accepting a leadership role at Wesley, I commit myself to the following covenant:

- I will seek to know and serve God.
- I will fulfill my LEAD commitments:
 1. Attend Wesley Wednesday night services
 2. Attend LEAD Prayer before services
 3. Attend weekly discipleship meetings
 4. Be actively involved in the ministry area to which I am assigned

- I will live a life of celibacy outside of marriage, and I will live above reproach and avoid even the appearance of immorality in all my relationships. This includes purity in dating relationships and forbids sleeping over with the opposite sex.
- I will live a life of sobriety.
 - If under 21, I will adhere to the law and not drink at all.
 - If 21 or over, I realize that drinking to excess and in certain settings could cause others to stumble. Therefore, when in Athens, I will refrain from the public consumption of alcohol. The only exception to this is that staff and leaders are allowed to drink modestly at meals in public settings.
 - I will refrain from even modest drinking at any sort of Wesley gathering (mission trip meetings, ministry area meetings, discipleship, etc)
- I will be above reproach in the way that I conduct and represent myself and Wesley on Social Media, Snapchat, etc.
- With regard to the life of purity to which I am called, I will guard what I watch, read, and listen to.
- With regard to all of the above, I will submit myself to those in authority over me (interns and directors) and make myself accountable to them, as unto the Lord.
