

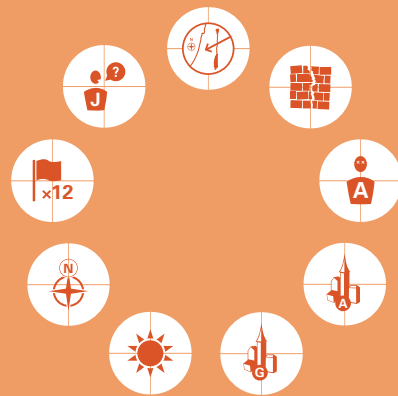


HISTORY

 The book of Joshua

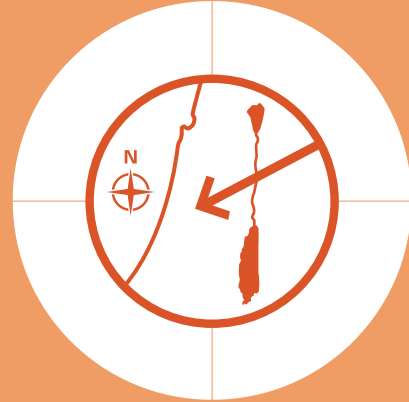


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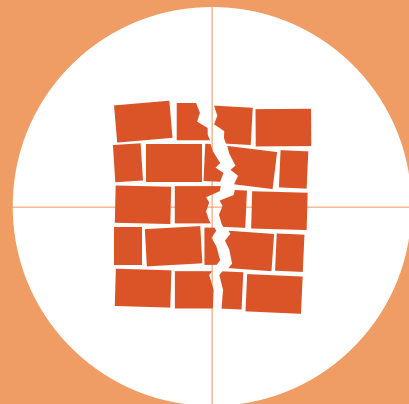


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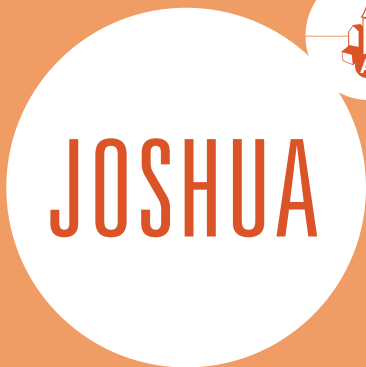
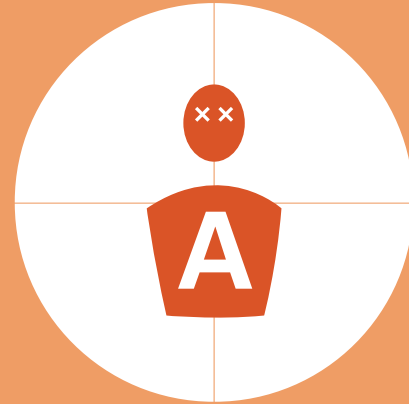
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
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




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
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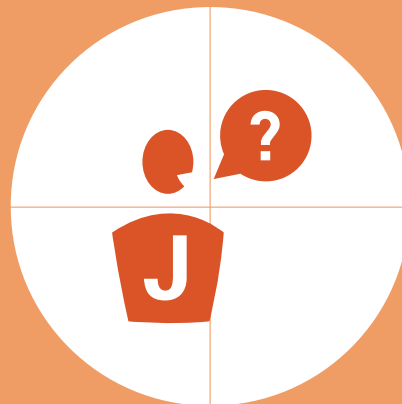
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JUDGES & RUTH

 The book of Judges

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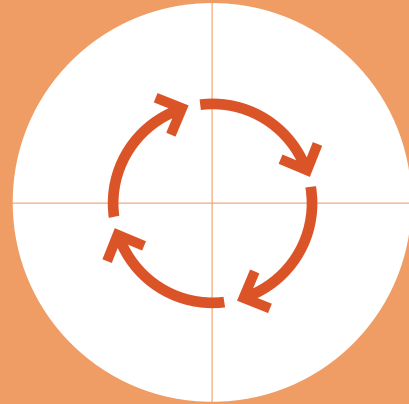


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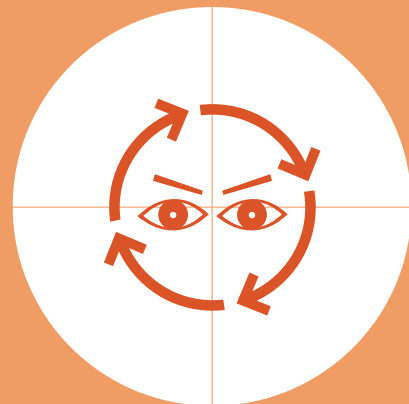


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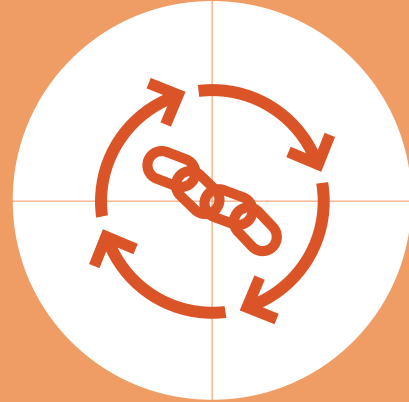


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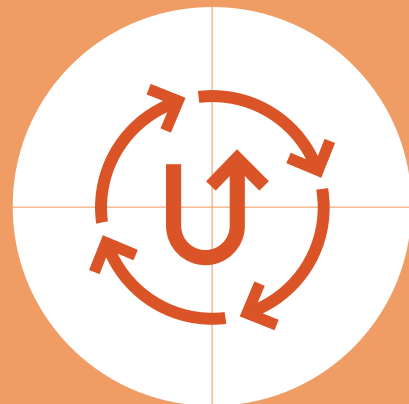


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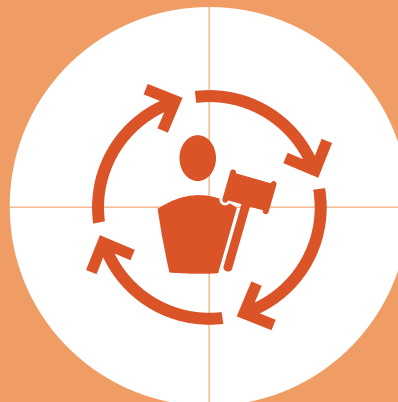
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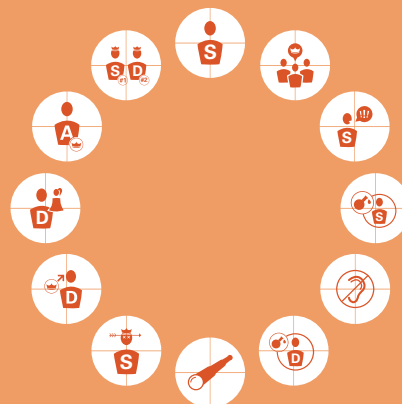

The books of Samuel

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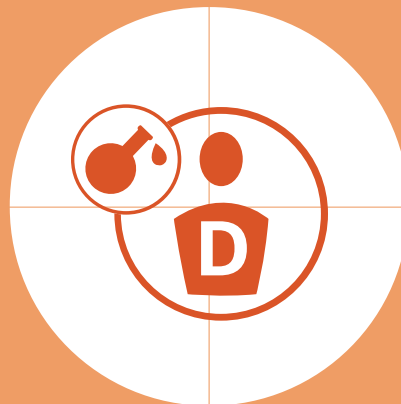
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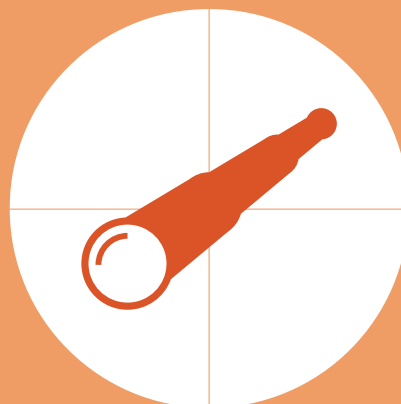
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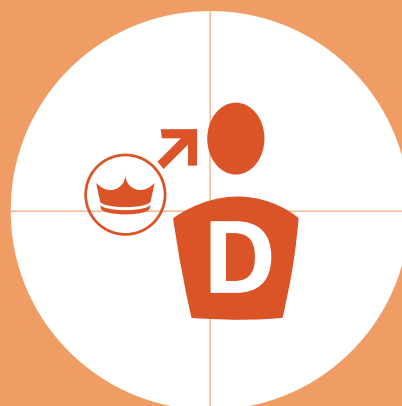


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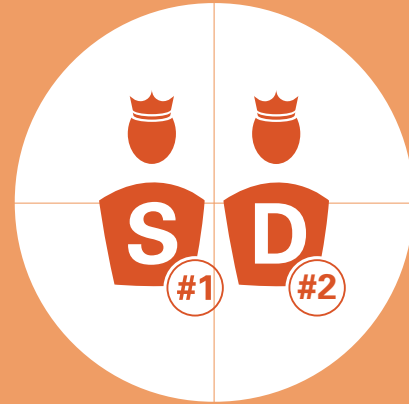


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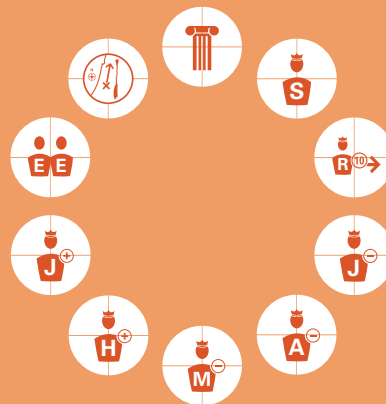
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1 & 2 KINGS

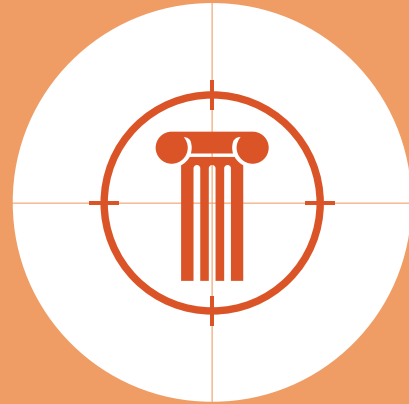


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EZRA- NEHEMIAH, ESTHER

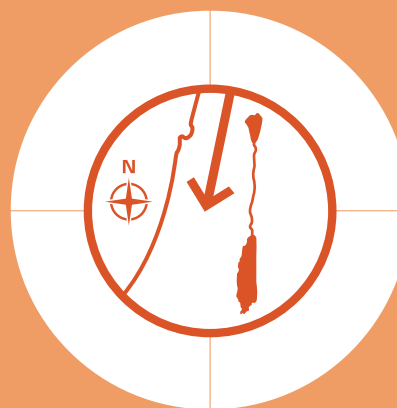
Ezra-Nehemiah and Esther

Saving her people there—Ezra,
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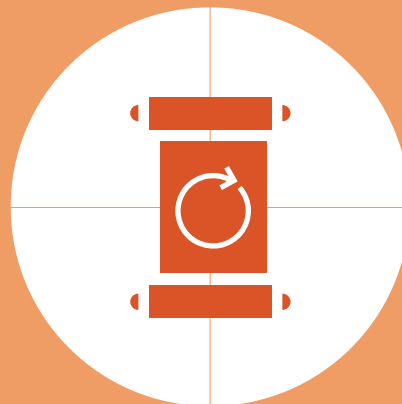
